SUBJECT: Deputizing the Municipal Mayors and Barangay Captains of the twelve (12) Municipalities in Bondoc Peninsula, Province of Quezon, comprising the municipalities of Agdangan, Buenavista, Catanauan, General Luna, Macalelon, Milanay, Padre Burgos, Pitogo, San Andres, San Francisco, San Narciso and Unisan, as Deputy Fish Wardens


Pursuant to the provisions of Section 40 of Presidential Decree No. 704, as amended, and the Letter of Instruction No. 550, the above mentioned officials whose names appear in the attached list are hereby appointed as Deputy Fish Wardens of the Ministry of Natural Resources/Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources, to take effect immediately.

By virtue of this deputation, the fish wardens are hereby authorized to detect violations of fishery laws, rules and regulations administered by the Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources and to arrest, even without warrant, any person who has committed or is committing in their presence any of the offenses defined in Sections 33, 34, 35, 36 and 37 of Presidential Decree No. 704, as amended by Presidential Decree Nos. 1015 and 1058 and Fisheries Administrative Order No. 134 and authorized to seize/confiscate the boats, gears, tools, its equipment and paraphernalia used in the commission of the offense/s, including the catch thereof as instruments or proceeds of the crime, pursuant to Article 45 of the Revised Penal Code. In all instances of detention, arrest, apprehension and/or seizures or confiscations, the period prescribed by law from the time of arrest and seizure shall be observed and file the proper information with the appropriate officials designated by law to conduct preliminary investigation and cause the filing of Information in Court by the Fiscal's Office through the Officer-in-Charge of the Fishery Station or Provincial Fishery Officer or Regional Director, whoever is most expediently available.



They shall also submit a monthly accomplishment report to the Director of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources through the Regional Director and/or respective Provincial Fishery Officer.
