Optimizing the Use of the Values of Natural Antiquity as Forest Capital of the Ministry of Natural Resources.

In pursuant to Section 89 of Presidential Decree No. 705, the following are
deputized as FOREST OFFICERS of the Ministry of Natural Resources/Bureau of
Development, effective upon receipt hereof, of which this Office shall be
advised accordingly:

In virtue of their deputation, they are authorized to detect violations of forestry laws and regulations administered by the Bureau of Forests and to arrest, ever without warrant, any person who has committed, is about to commit or is about to commit in your presence any of the offenses defined in Art. 62, 63, 71 and 77 of Presidential Decree No. 705, within your jurisdictions. They are also authorized to seize/confiscate the tools used in committing the offense and forest products cut, gathered or tendered in the places of committing the offense. In addition, arrest and seizure or confiscation, they shall do what is prescribed by law from the time of arrest and seizure, the chief forest ranger, the state equipment, and file the complaint.


with, the appropriate official designated by law to conduct
any investigation and file the information in court through the District
or Regional Director.

Subject to Section 45 of P. L. I., they are authorized to administer an oath
of acknowledgement in official matters connected with the functions of their
office to take testimony in official investigations conducted under the
law of the Revised Forestry Code of the Philippines and its implementing
and regulations.


They shall submit to the District Forester, San Jose Antique
monthly report of the cases they have handled pursuant to this Order.

This delegation shall be automatically revoked upon termination of their
term of Office unless sooner terminated by this Office.
