SUBJECT: Adopting a scheme to assure
legitimate sources of log
supplies for local wood processors
in the form of Domestic Log Sales
Declaration (DLSD)

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 30 of PD 705 as amended by PD 1559 otherwise known as the "Forestry Code" and upon consultation with the Philippine Wood Products Association (PWPA), the following rules governing domestic log sales are hereby promulgated:

1. The privilege to buy and sell logs in the domestic market shall be limited among PWPA members certified to be in good standing, who have valid Timber Licenses and/ or Wood Processing Permits at the time of the consummation of the sale.
2. A certified list of PWPA Members in good standing covering a six-month period shall be furnished the District Foresters (DF) of the Bureau of Forest Development (BFD) and the same shall be updated by the PWPA Head Office every three months or as often as necessary.
3. All domestic log sales shall be covered by DLSD forms, as hereto attached, to be executed by both buyer and seller, and attested by the DF or in his absence his duly authorized representative. The DLSD shall be prepared in seven copies, to be filed and distributed, post haste, by the DF-Origin as follows:
 - 1) To accompany shipment
 - 2) To BFD Central Office, Law Enforcement Div.
 - 3) To DF-Destination
 - 4) To DF-Origin for file

- 5) To Buyer
 - 6) To Seller
 - 7) To PWWA Head Office, 118 Perea St.
Legaspi Village, Makati, Metro Mla.
4. The Buyer shall submit the DLSD accompanying the shipment to the DF-Destination so the latter could monitor the arrivals of logs covered by the DLSD and report on the same to the BFD Director.
 5. The BFD shall use the DLSD form as basis for monitoring the rate of procurement of log supplies by wood processors as well as the disposition by timber licensees of their log production, making sure that domestic marketing of logs moves to and from legitimate origins and destinations.
 6. All administrative orders, circulars and memoranda inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.
 7. This Order shall take effect immediately and shall be in force until otherwise revoked/ revised in writing.
