The Resources, Environment and Economics Center for Studies, Inc. (REECS) will conduct a project study entitled "An Institutional Assessment of the Integrated Protected Area Fund (IPAF) in the Philippines". Among the objectives of the study are:

- 1. to characterize the protected areas in the Philippines relative to their funding structure and features;
- 2. to identify and evaluate the factors that influence the performance of IPAF implementation;
- 3. to assess the influence of IPAF implementation on resource extraction and development in protected areas and inflow of other funds into the protected areas; and
