SUBJECT: Clarification on DENR Memorandum dated

December 08, 2004

In relation to the DENR Memorandum from the Secretary dated December 08, 2004 canceling all logging/cutting permits in Quezon Province and suspending all logging/cutting permits in other provinces in the country, please be guided by the following clarifications:

- 1. the movement, transport and/or delivery of logs and/or manufactured/processed wood products harvested from Aurora and Quezon provinces to any point of destination outside said areas are strictly prohibited;
- 2. the movement. transport, and/or delivery all manufactured/processed wood products (i.e. lumber, veneer, plywood, wooden furniture, wood-based panels, wooden matches and the like), all imported logs and wooden poles for processing, as well as wood products manufactured therefrom are not covered by the suspension order;
- 3. the movement of logs harvested before December 08, 2004 shall be allowed ONLY after proper inventory by the DENR and upon clearance by the Undersigned; and
- 4. the harvesting of planted trees and non-timber forest products from titled private lands registered with the DENR in UTM blocks, except in Quezon and Aurora provinces, is not covered by the suspension order and therefore allowed, subject to the monitoring by the DENR.
