(CBMA), which aims at establishing a working relationship on the areas of reforestation (Adopt a Mountain), Multipartite Monitoring Team, Information, Education, Communication thrusts, Coastal Resource Management and Herbal Medicine Project.

In connection to this, any Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) that will be entered into at regional and provincial level should carry a provision that specifically states:

- 1. The DENR will provide speakers or trainors to CBMA initiated seminars or training or DENR shall invite CBMA members to participate in DENR initiated seminar or training;
- 2. That deputation is not exclusive to CBMA members in areas where it operates.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the above premises, the parties hereto have as follows:
