SUBJECT : **Clarification on the Implementation of DAO 2004-65 Dated November 19, 2004 Pertaining to the Standardization of Fees for the Registration of Threatened, Non-threatened and Exotic Fauna Species under the Jurisdiction of DENR**

This pertains to the numerous queries from pet owners, hobbyist, zoo owners, private wildlife collectors and even from the DENR Field Offices, requesting clarification on the registration fees of threatened, non-threatened and exotic faunal species .

Due to the clamor and request of different Avian Council and Federation, including pet owners, hobbyist and private wildlife collectors to lower/reduce the fees prescribed under DAO No. 62 dated October 12, 2004, the registration fees of threatened, non-threatened and exotic faunal species, as provided for under Section 3 of DAO 2004-62, is further waived and amended pursuant to DAO 2004-65 dated November 19, 2004. These fees were promulgated to standardize the payment of registration fees for non-threatened, threatened and exotic animals including those critically endangered faunal species, and pave the way for encouraging private person(s) and entities to register their animals with the DENR within the prescribed registration period.

Further, the registration period as provided for under DENR Administrative Order 2004-67 dated December 22, 2004 was further extended for another sixty (60) days from December 10, 2004 until March 7, 2005.

In the best interest of the service and in order to give ample time to zoo owners, hobbyist, pet owners and private wildlife collectors to register their wildlife stock and facilities with the DENR, the filing of application for the registration of threatened, non-threatened and exotic faunal species in the possession of private person(s) and entities, as provided for under DENR Adm. Order No. 2004-58 dated August 31, 2004 is further extended for another sixty (60) days reckoned from the effectivity of this Order.

This Order amends DAO 2004-58 and shall take effect immediately.

SUBJECT : WAIVING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF DENR ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER (DAO) NO. 2004-62 RE: PRESCRIBING FEES AND OTHER GUIDELINES ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF DAO NOS. 2004-55 AND 2004-58 BOTH DATED AUGUST 31, 2004 PERTAINING TO THE REGISTRATION OF THREATENED, NON-THREATENED AND EXOTIC FAUNAL SPECIES UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF DENR


In the interest of the service and in order to give zoo owners, hobbyist, pet owners and private wildlife collectors the opportunity to have their wildlife stock and facilities registered with the DENR, the corresponding fees for the registration of threatened, non-threatened and exotic faunal species, as provided for under Section 3 of the DAO 2004-62, is further waived and amended as follows:

The issuance of the Certificate of Wildlife Registration (CWR) for non-threatened, threatened and exotic faunal species shall be imposed with the following fees:

| c. | 101 – 200 hd. | - | P750.00 |

All other provisions of DAO 2004-62 shall remain in force and in effect.

This Order takes effect immediately.
