SUBJECT	:	APPEAL FOR THE EXTENSION OF EXEMPTION FROM THE WEARING OF THE OFFICE UNIFORMS

We are respectfully forwarding the petition of some Central Office employees seeking to extend the exemption of the wearing of the uniforms until arrangements for new designs shall have been prepared by the Uniform Committee.

The employees' clamor is based on the following:

- 1. The present set of uniforms have been in use for more than three years and most of them appear worn out already.
- 2. It is impractical to purchase materials for the old set of uniforms since they are due for replacement soon.
- 3. The exemption would enable the employees to be more comfortable and therefore more effective during office hours.

We therefore recommend approval of the employees' petition for the extension of the exemption from the wearing of the office uniforms until the date of the wearing of the new uniforms should have been fixed. Employees who opt to wear the old uniforms may, however, continue to do so.
