SUBJECT : **ENJOINING ALL NDRRMC MEMBER AGENCIES AND RESPECTIVE REGIONAL COUNTERPARTS TO PROMOTE AND ADVOCATE THE NATIONAL TSUNAMI ADVOCACY CAMPAIGN**

1. In December 2015, the United Nations declared every 5<sup>th</sup> of November as the World Tsunami Awareness Day (WTAD). The UN General Assembly has called on all countries, international bodies and civil society to observe the day, in order to raise tsunami awareness and share innovative approaches to risk reduction. It also asked the United Nations on Disaster Risk Reduction (UNDRR) to facilitate the observance of WTAD in collaboration with the rest of the United Nations system.
2. From 2016-2019, DOST-PHIVOLCS led the country's observance through the conduct of seminars, media conferences, audio-visual presentations of tsunami survivors, interactive exhibits, unveiling of tsunami signages, and tsunami evacuation drills.
3. For this year, DOST-PHIVOLCS is launching a national tsunami advocacy campaign that aims to promote tsunami resiliency across sectors in the country, to deepen the engagement of the community in initiating and sustaining tsunami awareness and

preparedness activities. As part of this, DOST-PHIVOLCS are conducting the **slogan- and digital poster-making online contests** with the theme "*Tsunami Awareness, Community Preparedness, and Proper Response in the New Normal*" to encourage the youth to participate in the said campaign. The winning entries will be used as campaign materials, not only for DOST-PHIVOLCS, but also by the various stakeholders.

4. In line with this, an **online press conference** dubbed as PHIVOLCS *InfoSentro*, will be held on 05 November 2020 at 9:00 AM to announce the winners and to rollout the said tsunami advocacy campaign. Further, **three (3) tsunami-related webinars** for public information are also set on 05 November 2020 at 2:00 PM, 10 November 2020 (pre-NSED activity), and at 07 November 2020.
5. The NDRRMC has supported the past WTAD activities. Hence, all NDRRMC Member Agencies and respective regional counterparts are enjoined to complement advocacy efforts in promoting the National Tsunami Advocacy Campaign.
