We're excited to hear your views on how we can take on the key challenges posed by the global pandemic, and take advantage of the opportunities it presents for our country.

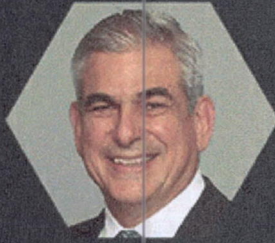
