Dear Director General Belgica:

This is to respectfully submit the list of pending applications of Smart Communications, Inc. (SMART) with the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) as requested by your office during the recent Consultation Meeting. To date, SMART has One Hundred Four (104) Special Land Use Permit (SLUP) and Thirty one (31) Special Use Agreement in Protected Areas (SAPA) applications in various regions.

Sometime in November 2018, we had a conference with all the Regional Directors of DENR to convey our desire to secure SLUP and SAPA. It is, however, unfortunate that despite several technical conferences that followed, we only managed to secure nine (9) SLUPs. The outbreak of COVID 19 pandemic early this year and the continuing pandemic challenge next year, 2021, will definitely slow down the process even further.

While we continue to coordinate with the DENR Regional Directors, we see the need to revisit the policies that are causing the delays. While we understand the need to comply to prevent tenurial penalties and threats of closure, we would like to suggest alternative ways to process the SLUP under the "new normal". These suggestions will ensure the safety of our people while we see the progress in accomplishing the pending permits. Please find hereunder the following suggestions and recommendations:

As you may be aware, a telecommunications tower ordinarily occupies only more or less three hundred (300) square meters. The infrastructure environmental footprint of SMART is very small compared to those in extractive industries and yet we are subjected to the same stringent DENR application process. Telecom projects are not identified in Presidential Proclamation 2146 as an environmentally critical project (ECP), which requires an impact assessment and environmental compliance certificate, wherever it is located. However, mindful of our duty to preserve the environment especially in Protected Areas, we still commit to provide a description of our project, outlining how we will manage our environment impacts. We do hope though that requirements and processes be more 'relaxed' in recognition of our non-extractive nature.

As the outbreak of the coronavirus continues, telecommunications play a vital role to public health and safety. With the government's implementation of community quarantine, social distancing protocols, and stay-at-home directives, we are conducting most of our daily activities while staying at home. With this new norm, we rely heavily on telecommunications to enable us to conduct our affairs and communicate with our family, friends and loved ones.

In his 5th State of the Nation Address, President Rodrigo R. Duterte urged the telecommunications companies to improve their services and to speed up the network roll out. In support thereof, your office together with the Department of Information and Communications Technology (DICT) have taken the lead in reducing the bureaucratic inefficiencies by streamlining all processes relative to the issuance of permits, licenses and certifications for the construction of telecommunications infrastructure. The Congress has likewise suspended telcos permits under Bayanihan 2 law that will result to faster construction of towers and other facilities.

In this light, SMART reaffirms its commitment to improve coverage and connectivity. In fact, SMART will build more telecommunications towers/facilities and accelerate its goal of improving customer experience across the country. With your help, we hope to secure Provisional Permits from the DENR, pending evaluation or completion of requirements. We are however willing to settle the assessed fees immediately.
