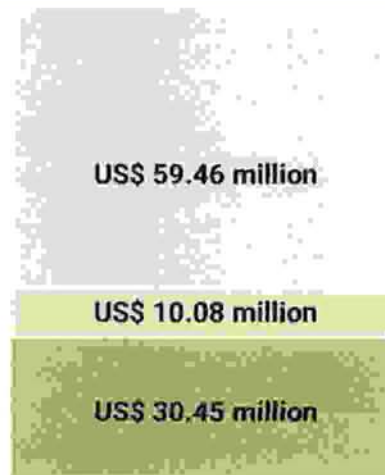

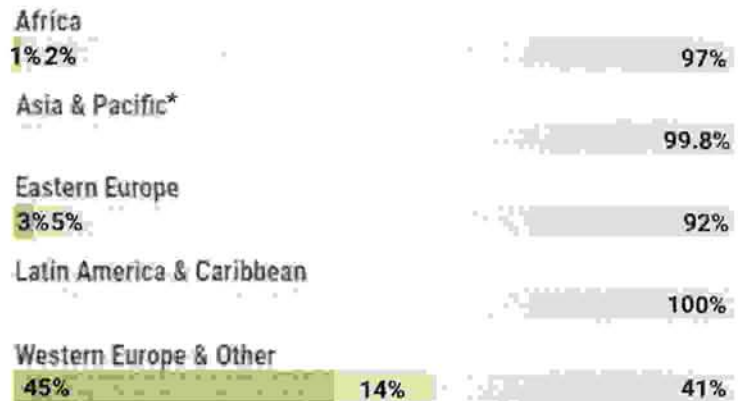

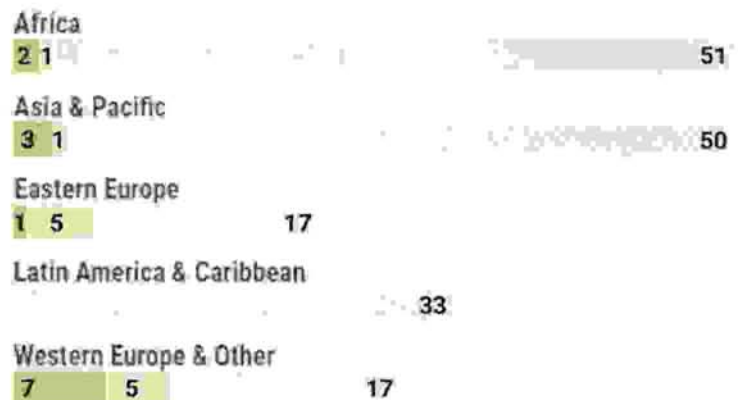

Income vs unfunded balance of USD 100M budget

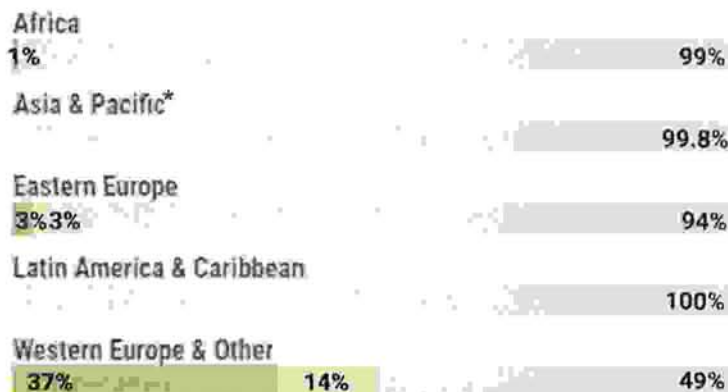

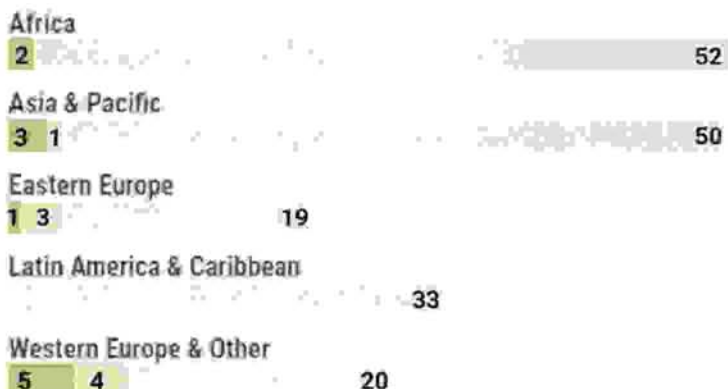
