Respectfully providing your Office with the **DENR-ADR Committee Accomplishment Report for FY 2017-2019** containing the activities and accomplishments of the DENR-ADR Committee relative to its mandate to institutionalize Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) in the Department.

The ADR Committee activities since 2017 are each different in terms of implementation and purpose, but all led toward the goal of mainstreaming the provision of ADR services to advance the Agency's objectives of providing disputing parties an alternative ways to settle their disputes. The initiatory phase of institutionalization includes ADR programs and activities like: (1) ADR and the ADR Mechanism Implementation (2) Promotion and facilitate the broad and effective use of alternative dispute resolution processes in the Department (3) Establishment of Regional Pool of ADR Officers (4) Institutionalization and Promotion of ADR System through training and capaciting DENR employees to be an accredited third-party neutrals (5) Provision of support to the conduct of ADR processes by the ADR Officers, the Department's accredited third-party neutrals and variety of stakeholders involvement. These programs and activities established the foundation for the ADR programs and initiatives which could be expanded to the other sectors of the Department not just in the land sector.

We recognize the support, efforts and cooperation of your Office contributing to the institutionalization and implementation of the ADR System in our Department through the land sector dispute resolution.

We hope this Accomplishment Report for the initial phase of the institutionalization will serve as reference and information as we move towards the compliance in the provision of ADR services as an alternative in settling disputes.
