The Biodiversity Management Bureau, together with its partner agencies in the National Cave Committee, will be conducting the "Learning Event on Assessment of Different Cave Values" through a three-day webinar series. This Learning Event aims to:

- 1. Capacitate DENR personnel in assessing cave values such as geological, hydrological, paleontological, archaeological, and cultural;
- 2. Enable DENR personnel to conduct sound assessment of cave values with the use of standard assessment methods/parameters; and
- 3. Improve the cave assessment form based on the comments and suggestions of participants and trainers on the parameters of each cave values.
