

Expenses incurred during the activity, including accommodation, meals, venue, activity materials, and honoraria of facilitators/resource persons shall be charged against the DA OSEC Funds earmarked for NCI-SRD, subject to existing government auditing and accounting rules and regulations. Traveling expenses and per diem of the participants shall be charged against the funds of respective agencies concerned.
