Member States are invited to fill in the online nomination at https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/AEEA-nomination_2021. Please note that applications are only accepted through the online nomination form, not via email.

Since 2015, the Asia Environmental Enforcement Awards publicly recognize and celebrate **excellence in enforcement by government officials and institutions or teams combating transboundary environmental crime**. The Awards are given to individuals and/or government organizations/teams working on fighting transboundary environmental crime in Asia (or on fostering Africa-Asia cooperation in the area of illegal trade in wildlife for that category) that demonstrate outstanding leadership in enforcement of national laws to combat transboundary environmental crime. The thematic scope of the Awards covers any transboundary environmental crimes, such as illegal trade in wildlife, illegal trade in chemicals or waste, including plastic, all of which become increasingly significant in the COVID19 response and recovery era. The Awards will be awarded by UNEP in partnership with UNDP, UNODC, the CITES Secretariat, the WCO and INTERPOL.
