**SUBJECT :** SUBMISSION OF DATA ON REVERSION CASES IN THE  
DIFFERENT REGIONAL OFFICES OF THE DENR

This has reference to the mandate of the Anti-Fake Titles Committee to conduct a continuing inventory of illegally/irregularly issued registered patents/land titles nationwide pursuant to Special Order 2017-236.<sup>1</sup>

In order to complete the inventory of the cases which are pending in courts, you are hereby directed to submit updated inventories of reversion cases in your area of jurisdiction, and certificates of title which are under investigation for the possible initiation of reversion cases.

With regard to reversion cases which are pending in courts within your area of jurisdiction, please indicate the following data in your report<sup>2</sup>:

- a) Case title;
- b) Docket number;
- c) Venue;
- d) Ground relied upon for the reversion of the subject land to the mass of public domain;
- e) Handling lawyer or action officer in the Regional Office and his/her counterpart in the Office of the Solicitor General;
- f) Status of the case;
- g) Current condition of the subject land; and
- h) Whether administrative case/s against DENR employees who were responsible in the irregular/illegal issuance of patents were instituted and the complete details thereof.


With respect to certificates of title, which are under investigation for the possible initiation of reversion complaints, please incorporate the following information in your report:

- a) Original or Transfer Certificate of Title (OCT/TCT);
- b) Name of Title holder;
- c) Lot description (including the area and location);
- d) Possible ground (e.g. title issued over forest land);
- e) Handling lawyer or action officer; and
- f) Status/remark.

Your offices are directed to comply with the inventory templates attached, for the sake of uniformity. **Please submit your reports on or before, 31 January 2020 addressed to the Secretary, through the Assistant Secretary, Legal Affairs, copy furnished this Office.**
