Related to this, updates on DAR's SPLIT Project were also presented and discussed by Assistant Secretary Joey Sumatra. Regions were reminded to be ready for the influx of volumes of DAR's Survey Returns for IVAS due to the full swing implementation of the SPLIT Project come CY 2022. The Regional breakdown of targets for Parcelization and Issuance of Individual Titles was also presented wherein a total of 1,368,883 hectares (613,888 hectares with Approved Survey Plan (ASP) and 754,995 hectares without Approved Survey Plan (ASP) for the 15 regions covering 78 provinces is targeted for the issuance of individual titles.

Included in the proposed budget of DAR is the allotment for Capital Outlay (PC hardware and software, equipment) and the hiring of Job Order to augment the existing manpower of the regions.
