May we respectfully refer a copy of the letter dated 25 January 2021 signed Undersecretary Brigido J. Dulay, Office of the Undersecretary for Civilian Security and Consular Affairs-Department of Foreign Affairs, regarding the submission by National Government Agencies (NGAs) of endorsements for entry and exemption of foreign nationals from the temporary suspension of visa issuance, pursuant to the key agreements in the Inter-Agency Task Force.

In order to avoid the falsification or recycling of agency endorsements, the DFA requests NGAs to:

- 1. Inform the DFA in writing of: (a) the designated/official email address that the NGAs will use to send endorsements to, and receive communications from, the Department; and (b) the designated alternate signatory of the head of the NGA, if any;
- 2. Ensure that the endorsement letter complies with the following:
 - a. Signed, not just initialed, by the head of the NGA or his/her designated alternate signatory;
 - b. Must be dated;
 - c. The name of the endorsed company and its focal person are stated in the body of the letter; and
 - d. The total number of endorsed foreign national/s (FN) is indicated in the body of the letter and not merely referenced to an Annex.

The DFA likewise wishes to reiterate that endorsement letters should come with complete information/documents to facilitate the seamless processing of endorsements, as follows:

- 1. Full name, passport details, and contact details (email and mobile number) of the FN; and
- 2. If FN has a valid/existing visa, the visa type and validity. If FN has no valid/existing visa, the location of the Philippine Embassy or Consulate where the FN will apply for a visa.

Pursuant to IATF Resolution Numbers 92 and 95, the DFA requests that separate endorsement letters be made for FNs from travel-restricted countries and those from non-travel restricted countries, and clearly stating in the endorsement letter whether the endorsed FNs come from travel-restricted countries or from non-travel restricted countries.
