This refers to the Performance Assessment of the Regional Key Officials (REDs, Supervising PENROs, Implementing PENROs and CENROs) for the conferment of "Environmental Awards for Governance and Leadership Excellence (EAGLE)" for CY 2021.

As per DENR Memorandum Circular 2021-11, "Guidelines on the Grant of FY 2021 Performance-Based Bonus (PBB)" dated September 30, 2021, the National Focal, Central Office Focals and concerned Staff Bureaus will assess the Means of Verifications (MOVs) submitted by the field offices. For the Performance Result dimension, the PPS-PMED and the Staff Bureaus will be responsible for rating the field offices.

Considering that the 2021 PBB Guidelines was modified by the AO 25 IATF as well as the rating/point system, the PBB/EAGLE Secretariat devised a new reference rating scale using the three parameters of Quantity, Quality and Timeliness which you can use as basis in the rating of the field offices (see matrix below).

Further, be reminded that the focal offices have the liberty to decide which combination to be used in rating the indicators taking into consideration the following conditions:

- For indicators with fixed and non-exceedable target -use Quality and Timeliness;

- For indicators that are not fixed and can exceed target without prescribed time of processing and issuance/submission -use Quantity and Quality;

- For those indicators that are not fixed and can exceed target with prescribed time of processing and issuance/submission - use 3 parameters (Q1, Q2 and Timeliness)

Relative thereto, you are requested to submit the results of the evaluation to the Program Monitoring and Evaluation Division (PMED) **not later than March 18, 2022.** This will serve as basis in determining the officials who will qualify for Phase 2. Attached is the matrix of the final list of indicators for your reference and information.
