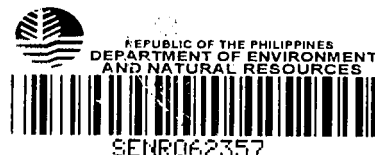

In September of last year, we launched the **Duterte Legacy: Barangayanihan Caravan towards National Recovery** project together with the Presidential Communications Operations Office (PCOO) and other partner agencies in all regions of the country. 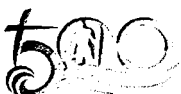
