
**Subject** : **PCOO REQUEST FOR SURVEY RESPONDENTS**

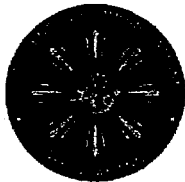
