This refers to the upcoming Duterte Legacy Summit 2022 spearheaded by the Presidential Commission Operations Office (PCOO) to be held on May 30-31, 2022, through hybrid face to face forum at the Philippine International Convention Center (PICC), Pasay City and virtual platform.

The Duterte Legacy Summit has an overall theme "Change has come: We Have Matatag, Maginhawa, at Panatag Na Buhay". The event will be the culmination of the Duterte Legacy campaign, which aims to exhibit, promote, and showcase the government's landmark achievements.
