This refers to the upcoming Duterte Legacy Summit 2022 spearheaded by the Presidential Commission Operations Office (PCOO) to be held on May 30-31, 2022, through hybrid face to face forum at the Philippine International Convention Center (PICC), Pasay City and virtual platform.

The Duterte Legacy Summit has an overall theme "Change has come: We Have Matatag, Maginhawa, at Panatag Na Buhay". The event will be the culmination of the Duterte Legacy campaign, which aims to exhibit, promote, and showcase the government's landmark achievements. Moreover, the summit will showcase the real stories of the various beneficiaries of the administration's landmark policies and programs from different sectors, including: local communities, grassroots leaders, families, laborers, among others.
