

Subject: Visit to the Headquarters of the Amazon Protection System

Dear Sir/Madam:

The Department of Foreign Affairs wishes to report that PH Ambassador Mario F. Chan, together with other ASEAN Heads of Missions in Brazil, visited the Centro Gestor e Operacional do Sistema de Proteção da Amazônia – CENSIPAM (Management and Operational Center of the Amazon Protection System)<sup>1</sup> in Manaus, Brazil.

CENSIPAM is an agency under the Brazilian Ministry of Defense that undertakes monitoring and protection of the Amazon by providing satellite imagery and informational data to Brazilian security forces. It helps in deterring activities detrimental to the Amazon and its populace, including deforestation, illegal mining, and organized criminal activities crossing Brazilian borders from neighboring countries of the Amazon.

Various advanced technologies are in use in CENSIPAM, including conventional air support (e.g., Brazilian Force assets), drone surveillance units, and space orbiting satellites that transmit real-time Amazon surface information. Information gathered by CENSIPAM is then cascaded to the relevant government agency dependent on the type of action required (e.g., environmental protection, meteorological assessment, immigration enforcement, police intervention, etc.).

According to CENSIPAM authorities, their technology is purely Brazilian developed through partnership between the government, the private sector and the academe. CENSIPAM also shared their willingness to build international partnerships with countries interested to apply their technology in other settings.

Worth noting during the visit was the mention of the Blue Amazon Management System<sup>2</sup> which integrates the Brazilian Navy's monitoring of both inland Amazon waters and the Brazilian South Atlantic into a single defense and security system. While the system is centered on the Brazilian Navy's primary competencies, it is also integrated with Brazilian police enforcement, environmental protection agencies, customs enforcement, and energy exploration activity (Petrobras).

The Department hopes that concerned agencies find the above information useful and relevant in exploring possible opportunities and evaluating the feasibility of pursuing any cooperative activities with CENSIPAM in the future.
