This pertains to the e-mail dated 08 June 2022, from the E-Commerce Programme Office of the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) requesting among others, the submission of listing of keywords, images, and other information on regulated products for regular sweeping by the online platforms, following the first inter-agency meeting on the implementation of Joint Administrative Order No. 22-01, series of 2022.

BACKGROUND

On 04 March 2022, Joint Administrative Order No. 22-01, series of 2022 on the *Guidelines for Online Businesses Reiterating the Laws and Regulations Applicable to Online Businesses and Consumers* was issued, following a series of consultations and meetings with regulatory agencies on its drafting.

The measure aims to apprise online sellers, merchants, or e-retailers on the existing laws and regulations that apply to offline and to online businesses as well. This is in response to the sharp increase in complaints on online transactions that DTI has received as a result of the huge proliferation of online businesses and e-commerce transactions ever since the onset of the pandemic.

ACTION REQUESTED

Following the meeting, DTI requested the member agencies to the JAO to submit listing of keywords, images, and other relevant information on regulated products that could help in their regular sweeping of violating posts in online platforms.

In this regard, we would like to request for your inputs on the attached matrix we have initially drafted based on your presentation during the *Online Discussion on Existing*

Environmental Laws and Regulations Governing Online Businesses we conducted on 27 January 2022, and other relevant materials we found.
