The convention will be conducted Hybrid (a combination of Face-to-Face and online) and the registration fee is **Eight Thousand pesos (PhP 8,000.00) for live-out** or **Twelve Thousand pesos (PhP 12,000.00) for live-in per participant** to cover the convention kit, meals during the sessions, and hotel accommodation, as applicable. While the registration fee for online participants is **Four Thousand Five Hundred pesos (PhP 4,500.00)**. Participation in this convention is subject to availability of funds and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

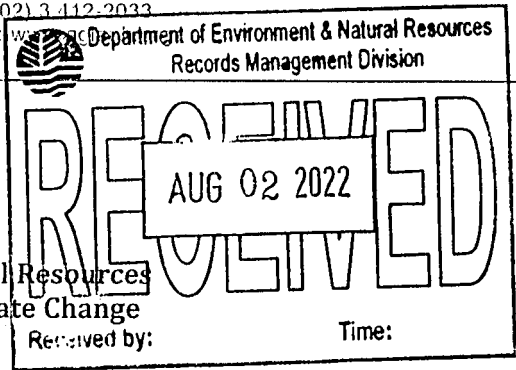

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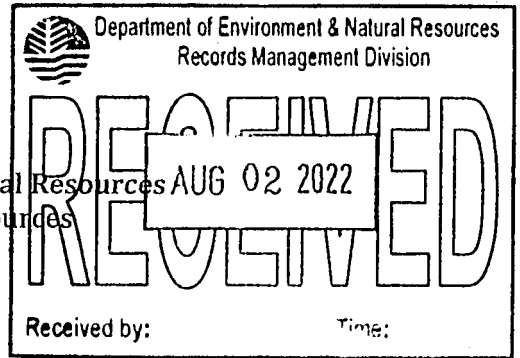
