The registration fee of One Thousand Five Hundred pesos (PhP 1,500.00) per participant shall be paid in cash or check to PSTD, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Since attendance to the training is exempted from the provision of Administrative Order No. 103 dated 31 August 2004, the registration fee shall be charged against their respective office funds.


