SUBJECT : **SUBMISSION OF AMENDED 2022 PROJECT PROCUREMENT  
MANAGEMENT PLAN (PPMP) COVERING 2022  
CONTINUING APPROPRIATIONS**

Pursuant to Section 3.3 of National Budget Circular No. 587 dated 3 January 2022, Consistent with Section 68, General Provisions of the FY 2022 GAA and The President's Veto Message, all appropriations authorized under the FY 2022 GAA, shall be available for release, obligation, and disbursement for the purpose specified, and under the same General and Special Provisions of said GAA applicable thereto, in particular with item 3.3.2 Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE) and Capital Outlays (CO) until December 31, 2023, including construction of infrastructure projects, delivery of goods and services, inspection and payment.

In this regard, you are hereby requested to submit your approved amended 2022 PPMPs for your procurement requirements covering 2022 continuing appropriations not later than **23 December 2022** in coordination with the Budget Division to ensure consistency with FY 2022 continuing appropriations and in compliance with existing budgeting rules and regulations.

Failure to comply with the submission of your Approved PPMPs to the Property and Supply Management Division (PSMD) through the Procurement Management Section/BAC Secretariat will be a ground for the exclusion of your remaining procurement requirements for CY 2022.
