This refers to the invitation from the Department of Trade and Industry Assistant Secretary Atty. Allan B. Gepty dated 19 January 2022 to the conduct of the Preparatory meetings on 23 and 28 February 2022, and Mission meetings on 3 – 4 March 2022 as part of the ongoing 4th European Union Generalized Scheme of Preferences Plus (EU-GSP+) Monitoring Cycle.

BACKGROUND

The European Union Generalized Scheme of Preferences (EU-GSP) was created following United Nations Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD) recommendation which allows vulnerable developing countries to pay fewer or no duties on exports to Europe. The Philippines, as a beneficiary of EU-GSP+, benefit from enhanced trade relations with the EU, with considerable potential to advance economic growth, sustainable development, and good governance

Following the successful submission of the Philippines responses to the 4th EU-GSP+ Monitoring Scorecards on 15 September 2021, which the Department has submitted its commitment under the "Environment" issue, is now on the last stage process. Accordingly, the outcomes of the fourth (4th) EU-GSP+ Monitoring Mission will be crucial to the European Commission's country report on the Philippines that would dictate the country's future beneficiary status under the EU-GSP+ scheme.

The said Mission will be conducted from 28 February to 04 March 2022. The officials from the European Union will visit the Philippines and will engage the GSP+ interagency team in technical cluster meetings on 03 to 04 March 2022 to discuss the implementation of the country's commitments.

Likewise, in preparation for the upcoming mission, the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) will be conducting preparatory meetings that will discuss the arrangements for the Mission as well as the substantive preparations needed for the cluster meetings.
