INTRODUCTION:

Our proposal on tree planting of ancestral and non-ancestral lands and denuded forest lands in Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao will be funded by Royal Maharlika Tribes-One Nation and its foreign donors. Our organization and constituents will plant 15,000,000 trees all over the country. Luzon and Visayas will be planted each 5,000,000 trees and Mindanao with 10,000,000 trees.

In the climate portal, environmentalist stresses that trees grow, take in carbon from the air and store it in wood, plant matter, and in the soil, termed "carbon sinks." Forests play an important role in the global carbon cycle by soaking up lots of carbon dioxide that would otherwise live in the atmosphere. It is estimated that a fully matured tree can consume 22lbs of carbon dioxide per year and release enough oxygen for you to breathe for 2 years. Earth's forests and soil absorb about 30 percent of atmospheric carbon emissions, partially through forest productivity and restoration. According to the United Nations' Food and Agriculture Organization, about 7.3 million hectares (18 million acres) of forest are lost every year, and roughly half of Earth's tropical forests have already been cleared. If not given attention, this could rapid extinction of natural habitat and flora and fauna species. It will cause even extinction of human beings to very end.

It is our vision and mission to promote a resilient and sustainable environment in light of problems in climate change and rapid soil deterioration due to severe erosion, weathering and depleted soil fertility. It is a keynote that with establishing vegetation in denuded lands will protect the soil physical, chemical and biological properties of our soils to serve for more generations.

In this project proposal, RMT1-N will plan to develop agro-forestry in multi-cropping scheme and Slope Agriculture Land Technology, exploring the potential of upland agriculture by planting high valued fruit trees other than wood species of high demand, inter-cropped with high valued crops at lower canopy of vegetation structure. The high valued crops harvested will served the local and foreign markets.

The fruit production in multi-cropping system and slope agriculture technologies will open opportunities to rehab and convert denuded high lands for a productive areas. Overall, the projects in planting 15,000,000 trees, will be consulted with RMT1-N Team and cooperating government agency to fit type/species for inter-cropping schemes. The trees species and high valued fruit and vegetable crops will give path in addressing food security, poverty alleviation and environment preservation.

It is important to mention that our projects in this nature will need teaming up and participation central and local government, agencies, to name some like DENR, Bureau of Forestry, DA, DILG, DSWD, NCIP and other agencies and private organizations. One of the fruits of this project is that vast available lands will be transformed to sustainable community units that Filipinos, who flock in highly populated urban cities of the country will consider moving into vacant potential areas and get good opportunities of employment and livelihood. We see directing new opportunities in the highland, will alleviate poverty and improve productivity with abundant manpower, who can be trained by our RM Doctor of Humanities Private Institute Training Centres and Kabuhayan Program of our RM National Confederation Cooperatives.

Our theme—"By Cooperativism, together we succeed to promote peace and prosperity".

THE PROGRAM:

1. Scheme: Tree species – Rapid culture such as fast-growing tree species, example Paulownia, in demand in Japan.
2. Wood species – Eucalyptus, Gmelina Arborea, Acacia, Mahogany, Mulberry, Lapnisan (Agarwood), and etc.
3. Rubber – increase area of cultivation with introduction of rubber tire manufacturing tapping all harvested rubber trees planted.
4. Explore potential in the culture of Almaciga (*Agathis philippinensis*) Almaciga resin is used in the manufacture of varnishes, lacquer, soap, paint, printing inks, linoleum, shoe polish, floor wax, plastic, water proofing materials, paper sizing and many other products.
5. Fruit trees/crops - durian, mangosteen, lanzones, marang, rambutan, banana; adaptable apples, peaches, berries and other cold / temperate species; high valued miyazaki mangoes;
6. High valued vegetable crops: Asparagus, broccoli, kale, lettuce romaine, etc.

7. Slope and gullies – Bamboos and rattan.

GANNT CHART:

1. Planting: 50 hectares X 1000 trees/ha X 12 = 9,000,000 trees/yr.
2. For 15 million trees will take 2 to 3 years as timeline for completion.
3. Tree planting and logistics activities can be initiated between Year 1 and 2 because of site planning and seedling production/acquisition/nursery. During the 1st year, outsourcing of seedlings of wood species and fruit trees.
4. Land development for multi-storey cropping systems – high valued fruit and vegetable crops.
5. Acquisition and stocking of materials – fertilizers and organic fertilizers will need to be sourced from reliable supplier. Warehousing / logistics will be needed.
6. Budget preparations: material, labor and supervision.

STRATEGIC PLAN:

1. Execon Meeting for Economic-Social Preparations with Commissioners - on activities of tree planting.
2. Budget requirement.
3. Coordination with LGUs and government agencies.
4. GIS mapping – identification of sites; per request letter by DENR on specific sites for tree planting.
5. Technological Training Program under RM Doctor of Humanities Private Institute and coordinating government department/agency.
6. Material Requirement and Acquisition – from reliable suppliers.
7. Logistics and Warehouse Planning and Budget.
8. Supervision and Management.
9. Monitoring – Survival of trees, replanting and follow-up on plant care.

Why restore in the Philippines?

Logging, slash-and-burn agriculture, land development, and forest fires are major factors contributing to the high deforestation rate in the Philippines. Starting in the 1960s, Philippine mahogany was cut down almost entirely to extinction.
