With reference to the above subject, we are furnishing you a copy of the letter from Atty. Kazel C. Celeste, Undersecretary DAR-FOO and PARC Council Secretary to DENR Secretary Maria Antonia Yulo Loyzaga dated 05 January 2023 and FY 2023 General Appropriation Act (RA No. 11936) enacted budget (copies hereto attached) as basis for the renewal of appointments/contracts of personnel on casual/contractual status, funded under DENR-CARP fund 101.

Please be informed that the 4th tranche of the salary adjustment authorized in the Salary Standardization Law of 2019 (SSL 5) and 14th month budgetary requirements for the 237 DENR-CARP authorized positions is already included in the FY 2023 enacted budget.

In addition, while our CY 2023 Work and Financial Plan and Regional plantilla are not yet signed by the approving authority, field offices are reminded that renewal/hiring of appointments of CARP casual personnel this CY 2023 should be based on the level and authorized plantilla positions in CY 2022.

Dear Secretary Loyzaga:

This has reference to the renewal of appointments of DENR-Comprehensive Agrarian Reform Program (CARP) personnel, pursuant to Presidential Agrarian Reform Council (PARC) Executive Committee (ExCom) Resolution No. 2014-122-01, Series of 2014 entitled, "Resolution Authorizing the Heads of Concerned CARP Implementing Agencies (CIAs) to Hire or Renew Appointments of CARP Casual/Contractual Personnel Effective 01 January 2014 Until the Termination of the Program" (copy attached).

The aforementioned Resolution provides that the DENR is authorized to hire or renew the appointments of the DENR-CARP casual/contractual personnel. The said authority is subject to availability of funds, pertinent budgetary, civil service and accounting rules/regulations, and PARC ExCom's periodic evaluation/assessment on the need for the services of the said personnel vis-à-vis the tasks on hand.

Based on the DENR-CARP CY 2023 Budget Execution Documents (BEDs) and Approved Budget per National Expenditure Program (NEP), only two (2) activities remain to be implemented which include the Inspection, Verification and Approval of Survey (IVAS) and Community-Based Forest Management (CBFM) Program in the upland and coastal areas. The conduct of Public Land Survey (PLS) and distribution of Free Patents (FPs) for Public Alienable and Disposable (A & D) lands covered under CARP have been completed in December 2015. In view of the completion of the said activities, the manpower complement of the DENR-CARP was scaled down from the authorized 383 to 237 positions or a reduction/abolition of 146 positions.

Foregoing considered, the DENR is authorized to hire or renew the appointments of the DENR-CARP casual/contractual personnel for the 237 positions effective January 2023.

Thank you for your continuing support to the agrarian reform program.



Special Provision(s)

- 1. Integrated Protected Areas Fund. In addition to the amounts appropriated herein, the following funding sources, constituted into the Integrated Protected Areas Fund (IPAF) shall be used to finance projects and activities of the National Integrated Protected Areas System (NIPAS) in accordance
 - (a) Thirty Million Pesos (P30,000,000) from the twenty-five percent (25%) income generated by each protected area from the operations of the NIPAS and management of wild flora and fauna, deposited with the National Treasury and released subject to the submission of a Special Budget pursuant to Section
 - (b) Seventy-five percent (75%) income retained by each Protected Area Management Board (PAMB), deposited in an authorized government depository bank. In no case shall said amount be used for payment of Personnel Services.
- 2. Wildlife Management Fund. In addition to the amounts appropriated herein, Five Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (P5,500,000) shall be used for the conservation and protection of wildlife resources sourced from fines, damages, fees, charges, donations, endowments, grants or contributions collected or granted within the jurisdiction of the DENR, constituted into the Wildlife Management Fund in accordance with Sections 4 and 29 of R.A. No. 9147.

Release of funds shall be subject to the submission of a Special Budget pursuant to Section 35, Chapter 5, Book VI of E.O. No. 292, s. 1987.

Manager of Land Seventy Five Thousand Pesos (P47,575,000) and One Hundred Seventy Nine Million Thirty Six Thousand Pesos (P179,036,000) appropriated herein shall be used exclusively in support of the Land Survey and Distribution and Program Beneficiaries Development, respectively, under the Comprehensive Agrarian Reform Program.
