- Proposed Resolution on the Creation of the National Time Release Study Technical Working Group (NTRS-TWG).
  - In preparation for the adoption of the proposed resolution, may we seek your comments/inputs on the draft resolution, particularly on the proposed composition and membership of the NTRS-TWG. Additionally, the DTI, as chair for the Trade Policy Review Technical Working Group (TPR TWG) is also seeking the Department's recommendations on the conduct of border procedures in relation to the release and/or clearance of goods.
  - For reference, attached is the draft Resolution with revisions from the TPR.
- Report from the Chair of the Compliance Monitoring Technical Working Group (CMTWG), particularly on the implementation of TradeNet.
  - Please be informed that on 14 April 2023, during a sectoral meeting on improving bureaucratic efficiency, President Marcos approved the use of TradeNet as one of the single operating systems for all government transactions. In this regard, we would like to request your updates on the onboarding to the TradeNet.

# CREATION OF THE TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP ON NATIONAL TIME RELEASE STUDY (TWG-NTRS)

WHEREAS, Executive Order (EO) No. 136, series of 2021, provides for the creation of the Philippine Trade Facilitation Committee (PTFC), which shall streamline and improve customs procedures and facilitate the implementation of rational, efficient, and simple customs rules that will reduce the cost of trade transactions, and enable micro, small, and medium-sized enterprises to participate more actively in international trade;

WHEREAS, under Article 7.6 of the World Trade Organization-Trade Facilitation Agreement (WTO-TFA), "Members are encouraged to measure and publish their average release time of goods periodically and in a consistent manner, using tools such as, inter alia, the Time Release Study of the World Customs Organization (WCO);"

WHEREAS, under Section 2.3 of EO No. 136, the PTFC can call on the assistance of and coordinate with relevant government agencies and stakeholders on various trade and trade-related concerns covered by the WTO-TFA and other trade facilitation commitments;

WHEREAS, the PTFC, in compliance to the above provision of the WTO-TFA, has committed to conduct a National Time Release Study (NTRS) to measure the clearance and release time of goods;

WHEREAS, the PTFC, thru-through a meeting of its technical working groups (TWGs) has recommended the creation of a new TWG to conduct and supervise the NTRS;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED,** to approve the creation of the Technical Working Group on National Time Release Study, which shall be composed of the following:

**BE IT RESOLVED, FURTHER,** that the NTRS-TWG shall perform the following functions:

- a. Plan, conduct, and evaluate the result of the NTRS;
- b. Coordinate with and invite the participation of other concerned government agencies and stakeholders on the conduct of the NTRS;
- c. Work in close collaboration with the WCO TRS technical staff and accredited TRS experts nominated by the WCO;
- d. Determine and assess the performance of the government agencies concerned based on the TRS of import and export processes;
- e. Establish a baseline for trade facilitation performance measurement;
- f. Identify the bottlenecks in the supply chain for purposes of instituting possible corrective measures or trade facilitation improvements;
- g. Recommend possible corrective measures for creating a conducive environment for a seamless flow of goods, and opportunities for trade facilitation enhancements; and
- h. Perform such other functions as may be assigned.

**BE IT RESOLVED, FINALLY,** that a **NTRS-TWG** be created to conduct a National Time Release Study on the release and clearance of imported and exported goods.
