This refers to the letter dated 05 May 2023 from Atty. Lily Freida M. Milla, OIC Deputy Executive Director, and Director-in-Charge, International Affairs Service, requesting the DENR to nominate candidates for the 2023 scholarships for Master's Degree under the Thailand International Postgraduate Programme (TIPP) offered by the Thailand International Cooperation Agency (TICA). Detailed information on the scholarship program may be accessed at <https://tica-thaigov.mfa.go.th>.

Interested applicants shall possess the following qualification requirements of the DENR:

1. Have at least two (2) years holding permanent plantilla position in the DENR at the time of application;
2. Have obtained performance ratings of at least Very Satisfactory for the last two (2) consecutive rating periods;
3. Performing duties and responsibilities relevant to the field of study/travel being applied for;
4. Have no pending administrative case;
5. Have no pending application and nomination for other study and non-study trips;
6. Have not exceeded four (4) official foreign travel within a year;
7. Have submitted all the required reports from previous foreign travels
8. Have rendered the required service obligation for a scholarship previously enjoyed;
9. Must be willing to conduct a master's thesis aligned to the priority programs of the Department or related topics to be identified/approved by the DENR;
10. Must be willing to sign a scholarship service contract and shall serve the DENR with the corresponding period of service obligation;
11. Must not be a delinquent scholar; and
12. In good mental and physical health.

Qualified candidates shall submit their complete application requirements to the Career Development Division through this link [bit.ly/nomiforeign](https://bit.ly/nomiforeign) and/or QR code **not later than Monday, 26 June 2023**:



1. Memorandum addressed to the Chair of the Human Resource Development Committee (HRDC), attention HRDC Secretariat to be endorsed by Head of Office and concurred by Supervising Undersecretary and Assistant Secretary;
2. Resolution from HRDC Counterpart recommending the nomination of the applicant;
3. Service Record;
4. Certificate of no pending administrative case;
5. Certification from the Director supervising human resources/Assistant Regional Director for Management Service/Assistant Director (Region/Bureau/Attached Agency) stating that the applicant:
  - a. has no pending scholarship nomination;
  - b. has not been a delinquent scholar from a previous scholarship grant;
  - c. has submitted all the required reports from previous foreign travels.
6. Updated Personal Data Sheet, with Work Experience Sheet, duly signed by authorized person administering oath; and
7. Self Certification of official Travel History for the past 24 months;

The DENR HRDC shall screen and select qualified candidates for the program. Selected candidates will be notified and endorsed to the CHED International Affairs Services, to proceed with the application/admission process.

- a) Must be 40 years old and below provided the return service obligation is still within the nominee's serviceable years;
- b) Candidate must have rendered at least two (2) years of service;
- c) Must hold a permanent appointment;
- d) Must have a college degree related to the field of study or has sufficient demonstrated ability and experience along the field of study;
- e) Must not have a pending application for scholarship under another program; and
- f) Must have rendered the service obligation required under Executive Order 367 for scholarship recently concluded before he/she could again be nominated for another course where the field of study is different from the previous training.

  - c. Assurance of utilizing the services of the nominee, if accepted for a period of not less than two (2) years of every year of scholarship or a fraction thereof not less than six (6) months or as provided under E.O. 367 amending E.O. 129; and
2. Certified Copy of Service Record
3. Certified Copy of Statement of Actual Duties and Responsibilities
4. Photocopy of Transcript of Academic Records (Baccalaureate/Graduate)
5. Photocopy of Diploma
6. Certification that the nominee has no pending administrative and criminal case
7. Certification that the nominee has no pending scholarship nomination to other program
8. Updated bio-data/resume w/ list of in-service trainings and seminars attended (Spell out acronyms of organizer/s and topic/s or subject/s of the training) programs; certificates of training **NEED NOT** be submitted).
