to the ecotourism and management plan formulated under this Act.
Such buffer zone shall be included in the ecotourism development and
management plan of the NASLEZ; Provided, that no build-up or reclamation
detrimental to the diversity in the NASLEZ shall be done within the designated
buffer zone. The Council shall exercise its authority over the designated buffer
zone.
