SUBJECT : **RECOMMENDATION ON REGULATORY IMPACT ASSESSMENT TRAINING**

DATE : 22 MAY 2023

Pursuant to Section 5 of Republic Act No. 11032 otherwise known as the Ease of Doing Business Act of 2018, all proposed regulations related to the provision of services covering business and non-business-related transactions shall undergo Regulatory Impact Assessment (RIA). Existing regulations can also be subjected to RIA for the purpose of improving regulatory quality.

In order to smoothly implement RIA in the Department, we are recommending the Bureaus, from which most of the Department's regulatory policies emanate, to program and conduct a Training on RIA (whether basic or advanced) RIA for their respective personnel.

Your offices may tap the Development Academy of the Philippines or other training providers like the University of the Philippines NCPAG, both of which are tapped by the Anti-Red Tape Authority.
