This has reference to the 4th In-Person Negotiating Meeting and Related Meetings for Pillars I-IV of the Indo-Pacific Economic Framework for Prosperity (IPEF), which will be held in Busan, South Korea on 9-15 July 2023 (exclusive of travel time).

The 4th Negotiating Round will seek to achieve substantial progress in the negotiations for Pillars I, III, and IV and commence the legal review for Pillar II following the finalization of the Supply Chain Agreement in May 2023. For Pillar I, negotiations will continue for the chapters on Agriculture, Digital Trade, Environment, Inclusivity, Labor, Good Regulatory Practices, Services Domestic Regulation, Trade Facilitation, and Technical Assistance and Economic Cooperation.

Given the technical expertise and mandate of the DENR in pursuing the negotiating objectives of the Philippines in this undertaking, we respectfully request the in-person participation and leadership of the DENR in negotiating the Pillar I Environment Chapter of the IPEF. We also request the participation of the DENR in its capacity as a Resource Person for other Chapters under Pillar I. Similar to previous rounds, kindly note that the DTI will not be able to cover all meetings due to the parallel format of negotiations. There may also be technical difficulties with respect to virtual participation, which may affect the negotiators' ability to provide real-time comments and attributions during the meetings.


