**DATE : 30 JUN 2023**

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This pertains to the Briefing on the Conduct of Regional-National Investment Programming Dialogue held last 27 June 2023 via Zoom. Said Briefing was participated in by participants from the Regions and Public Investment Programs (PIP) focals from the Bureaus and Attached Agencies.

During the briefing, the following programs were proposed to be included in the top 30 priority PPAs of your respective RDC. These PPAs received the biggest budgetary allocation in the approved 2023-2028 PIP. Their inclusion in the top 30 regional priority PPAs will ensure the alignment of the Regional Development Investment Plans (RDIPs) of the RDC and the PIPs of the DENR.

1. Enhanced National Greening Program (Nationwide)
2. Protected Areas, Caves, and Wetlands Development and Management (Nationwide)
3. Forest Protection Program (Nationwide)
4. Protection and Conservation of Wildlife (Nationwide)
5. Management of Coastal and Marine Resources/Areas (Nationwide)
6. Implementation of an online water quality monitoring system in Laguna de Bay and its tributaries including portions of Manila Bay within the framework of the Manila Bay rehabilitation program (Interregional)
7. Air quality monitoring stations in HUCs (Interregional)

The project for the Construction of Waste-to-Energy (WTE) Facilities in Davao City is also one of the PPAs with high budgetary allocation. However, this Office would like to suggest to the concerned Region not to propose the project in the top PPAs' list of their RDC. Please be informed that the DENR Secretary wrote a letter to the Undersecretary for the Investment Programming Group of NEDA regarding the challenges in the implementation of the project. In the said letter, the Secretary

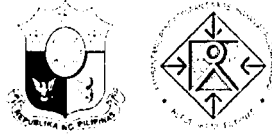
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deferred to the NEDA-Investment Coordinating Committee handling the risks involved in the project, such as the Environmental Impact Assessment Procedure (social acceptability and ensuring compliance with highest international emission standards), Land acquisition and Project (facility) Ownership, Financial Arrangement, and Contract Risks (Waste Management Service Contract and Power Purchase Agreement).

Moreover, please note that your respective RDC is not limited to the programs mentioned above. 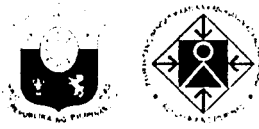

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This is a Call for the concerned Agency Central Offices (ACOs) and Regional Development Councils (RDCs) to participate in the subject Dialogue for the alignment of priority regional programs and projects (PAPs) with national/sectoral priorities and to undertake preparatory activities thereto. The Dialogue is planned to be held on the 4<sup>th</sup> week of July 2023.

The RDC Secretariats are requested to cascade the Call and the attached Guidelines for the conduct of the RNIP to their respective members.

**Conduct of the Regional-National Investment Programming Dialogue**

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## Background

1. The Philippine Development Plan (PDP) 2023-2028 serves as the country's six-year blueprint in development planning. It reflects the government's policies, strategies, programs, and legislative priorities in support of and consistent with the President's 8-point Socioeconomic Agenda.
2. Executive Order No. 14 (s. 2023)<sup>1</sup> states that, in support of the PDP, there is a need to identify the priority programs and projects that will be carried out by agencies for the period 2023-2028, which will be embodied in the Public Investment Program (PIP) 2023-2028.
3. As a six-year programming document accompanying the PDP, the PIP contains the priority PAPs to be implemented by national government agencies, government-owned and/or controlled corporations, government financial institutions, state universities and colleges, and other offices within the medium-term that achieve the target outcomes in the PDP.
4. Similarly, the Regional Development Investment Program (RDIP) serves as the accompanying programming document of the Regional Development Plan (RDP), as it contains priority PAPs of the regions which will operationalize the strategies laid out in their respective RDPs.
5. During the Formulation of the PIP 2023-2028, ACOs were instructed to ensure that all National Government PAPs that are included in the RDIPs, if available, and/or endorsed by the RDCs, which contribute to the sectoral outcomes in the PDP, are also included in the Agency PIP. The ACOs were required to seek the inputs of their regional offices, bureaus, and attached agencies in the preparation of their submission for the formulation of the PIP 2023-2028, including information on the regional priorities and proposed investment targets at the regional level<sup>2</sup>.
6. **The Dialogue as part of the PIP-RDIP Alignment Process.** The Dialogue aims to facilitate the linking of the RDIP to the PIP through aligning regional priorities with national/sectoral priorities. The ACOs and RDCs are expected to harmonize their respective sectoral and regional development plan targets and corresponding timelines over the PIP-RDIP period.

7. Accordingly, the ACOs and RDCs shall mutually identify the corresponding priority PAPs in the regions. These shall be included by the ACOs in their submission during the updating of the PIP 2023-2028, to commence in August 2023, as input to the FY 2025 budget preparation.
8. Attached, for reference and guidance, is the **Guidelines on the Regional-National Investment Programming Dialogue** (see *Attachment*), which contains details on the prerequisites and preparatory activities for the Dialogue, calendar of activities, mechanics, and expected outputs from the ACOs and RDCs for each step of the activity.
9. **Coverage of the Dialogue.** This Call covers twelve (12) pilot national government agencies with the highest region-specific investment targets based on the formulated PIP 2023-2028.
10. The concerned ACOs are required to participate in the Dialogue as this shall serve as part of the preparatory works for the upcoming updating of the PIP 2023-2028 as input to the FY 2025 budget preparation.
11. The ACOs and RDCs are requested to submit the names and designations of confirmed ACO and RDC participants for the Dialogue to the RNIP Secretariat **on or before June 19, 2023** (see *Annex B: Template for the List of Confirmed Participants for the RNIP Dialogue*). The allowed number of participants per ACO and per RDC are as follows:

## Guidelines on the Regional-National Investment Programming Dialogue

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### I. Background/Rationale.

The Regional-National Investment Programming (RNIP) Dialogue aims to facilitate the linking of the Regional Development Investment Program (RDIP) to the Public Investment Program (PIP) through aligning regional priorities with national/sectoral priorities. The Agency Central Offices (ACOs) and Regional Development Councils (RDCs) are expected to harmonize their respective sectoral and regional development plan targets and corresponding timelines over the PIP-RDIP period. The ACOs and RDCs shall identify the corresponding priority programs and projects (PAPs) in the regions. These shall be included by the ACOs in their submission during the updating of the PIP 2023-2028 as input to the FY 2025 budget preparation.

### II. Specific Objectives. The Dialogue aims to facilitate the following:

- a. The ACOs and the regions initiating the **harmonization of their regional sectoral targets, as determined in the respective Results Matrices (RM) of the Philippine Development Plan (PDP) 2023-2028<sup>1</sup> and development targets;**
- b. The ACOs and the regions identifying a harmonized list of **PAPs responsive to the regional sectoral targets (with agreed-upon implementation period)** based on Regional Development Plan (RDP) and Regional Development Investment Program (RDIP); and
- c. The ACOs, RDCs, and NEDA agreeing on the **harmonized timelines for the national and regional investment programming processes (investment programming calendar).**

### III. Coverage

This Call covers twelve (12) pilot national government agencies which were selected based on the top agencies which have the highest region-specific investment targets based on the formulated PIP 2023-2028 and as recommended by the NROs representing the Area Committees.

The concerned ACOs are required to participate in the Dialogue as part of the preparatory works for the upcoming updating of the PIP 2023-2028.

#### **IV. Participants and Roles**

- a. **Selected ACOs** to participate in the preparatory activities and Dialogue proper. These offices shall be represented by the officials authorized by the Head of Agency. The representative should be an Undersecretary, at least, and preferably from the planning office. Kindly note that representatives are only required to come to the activity **on the day of their presentation**.

The ACO PIP Focals which were previously authorized during the PIP 2023-2028 formulation in October 2022 will also serve as the RNIP Dialogue Focals of the ACOs (*see Annex A*)<sup>2</sup>.

The ACOs selected to participate in the RNIP Dialogue process are the following:

1. Department of Agriculture
2. Department of Education
3. Department of Energy
4. Department of Environment and Natural Resources
5. Department of Health
6. Department of Human Settlements and Urban Development
7. Department of Information and Communications Technology
8. Department of the Interior and Local Government
9. Department of Public Works and Highways
10. Department of Science and Technology
11. Department of Social Welfare and Development
12. Department of Transportation

- b. **The RDCs** to undertake preparatory activities and participate in the Dialogue proper.

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- c. **NROs**, as RDC Secretariat, to provide technical support to the RDCs in delivering the required outputs for the Dialogue, and coordinate with the RNIP Secretariat for technical and administrative concerns. The NRO Focals which were previously authorized during the PIP 2023-2028 formulation in October 2022 will also serve as the RNIP Dialogue focals of the NROs.
- d. **NEDA – Investment Programming Group (IPG) and Regional Development Group (RDG), with the Public Investment Staff and Regional Development Staff as focals**, shall serve as the Joint Secretariat for the RNIP Dialogue. The RNIP Secretariat shall also provide technical assistance to the NROs during the preparatory activities. The IPG and RDG Undersecretaries to provide overall guidance on the conduct of the RNIP Dialogue.
- e. **Concerned NEDA Sector Staffs**, as PIP Chapter Focals, may be requested to act as resource persons, as needed.

**V. Coordination Mechanism**

- a. The RNIP Secretariat shall set up a coordination mechanism with the RNIP Dialogue focals to facilitate the pre-, onsite, and post-activities of the Dialogue.
- b. The ACOs and RDCs are requested to submit to the RNIP Secretariat the names and designations of their confirmed participants for the Dialogue **on or before June 19, 2023** (see *Annex B: Template for the List of Confirmed Participants for the RNIP Dialogue*). The allowed number of participants per ACO and per RDC are as follows:

- c. Other interested participants may tune in to the Dialogue through an online streaming platform to be provided by the Secretariat.

## **VI. RNIP Dialogue Process**

### **a. Prerequisites and Preparatory Activities for the Dialogue**

Prior to the Dialogue, the concerned ACOs and RDCs, through the NROs, shall conduct and prepare the following activities and documents (templates for the outputs are also provided):

#### **i. ACOs to prepare their plan targets per region.**

**Deadline of submission:** June 23, 2023

The ACOs, in coordination with their respective Agency Regional Offices (AROs), if applicable, shall prepare the regional disaggregation of their national sectoral outcome targets for their priority sectors as identified in the PDP and its RM. [Attached as **Annex C** is the template for the ACOs' plan targets per region]. This may be supplemented/supported by a regional disaggregation of targets in the respective agency development plans. The ACOs shall transmit the same to the RDCs, copy furnished the NROs and RNIP Secretariat, prior to the preliminary technical meetings which will be discussed in detail in Item VI.a.iv.

#### **ii. RDCs' top 30 priority regional PAPs.**

**Deadline of submission:** June 30, 2023

Upon receipt of the Call, the RDCs, through the NROs, shall identify its 30 priority regional PAPs (i.e., standalone region-specific PAPs or interregional PAPs) based on the following:

1. Responsiveness to the PDP RM targets (2023-2028). These 30 PAPs may be culled from the available regional plans [e.g., RDIPs, Annual Investment Plans (AIPs), masterplans, and sectoral plans];
2. Responsiveness to the sectoral targets per region to be provided by the ACOs;
3. Compliance with the criteria for inclusion in the PIP (i.e., responsiveness, typology, and readiness) (*see Annex D, PIP Inclusion Criteria*) and endorsed by the concerned RDCs.

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[Attached as **Annex E** is the template for the List of Top 30 PAPs];  
and

4. Implementation readiness based on the readiness criteria under Item No. A.2 of Annex D. Please note that for this activity, only Tier 2<sup>3</sup> PAPs shall be included in the priority list.

The Regional Development Council (RDC) shall provide a concise justification on the cruciality of each project. The justification should encompass various factors, including but not limited to<sup>4</sup>:

1. *Potential foregone benefits (economic, social, and environmental, among others) if the project remains unimplemented;*
2. *Synergy with ongoing and future government PAPs:* This includes the positive impact from collaboration between the national and regional government; and
3. *Evident demand from various stakeholders for the project:* This can include statistics, surveys, or feedback indicating the pressing need for the project, as well as its potential benefits to the target population or sector.

The RDCs shall submit the top 30 priority PAPs to the concerned ACOs, copy furnished the RNIP Secretariat. In relation to the RDC approval of priority PAPs, an approval of the RDC Executive Committee may suffice in lieu of the full RDC.

- iii. **ACOs' response/s to the regions' proposed priority PAPs for inclusion in the agency PIP.**

**Deadline of submission:** July 7, 2023

ACOs shall prepare its responses to the RDCs' proposed list of priority PAPs. The ACOs shall also share the same in advance with the RDCs, copy furnished the NROs and the RNIP Secretariat, in

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preparation for the ACO-RDC technical meetings. [Attached as **Annex F** is the template for the ACO's responses].

**iv. Preliminary technical meetings between ACOs and RDCs, through their Sectoral Committee, and ACO presentation.**

**Deadline of submission:** July 21, 2023

Upon transmittal of ACO's responses to the RDCs' proposed priority PAPs, the NROs shall arrange technical meetings between select ACOs and the RDC Sectoral Committees, to be held within the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> weeks of July, to discuss and agree on the regional priority PAPs leading to the Dialogue.

The ACOs and RDC Sectoral Committees shall discuss any concerns in relation to the ACOs' acceptance of regional PAPs into their PIP, and prepare the agreed list of priority PAPs with tagging based on the following:

1. Regional PAPs that can be included in the agency PIP; and
2. Regional PAPs to be elevated for further discussion in the Dialogue:
  - a. Regional PAPs that were not included in the agency PIP and the reason for non-inclusion; and
  - b. Regional PAPs that may still be included but subject to further assessment of the ACO.

After the technical meetings, the ACOs shall prepare a presentation of the regional sectoral targets and shortlisted Agency priority PAPs per region. The ACO shall present the results of the technical meetings during the Dialogue, including updates on PAPs under further assessment for inclusion in the Agency PIP.

All ACOs shall submit their presentations to the RNIP Secretariat by July 21, 2023. [Attached as **Annex G** is the template for the ACOs' presentation].

**b. Mechanics of the Dialogue Proper**

The RNIP Dialogue Proper is scheduled to take place during the 4<sup>th</sup> week of July 2023 in Metro Manila. The RDC Chairperson, or in



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his/her absence, the Co-Chairperson, is expected to participate during the entire session.

Below are the detailed mechanics for the Dialogue proper:

- i. **ACO-RDC Discussions** – The ACOs shall present the regional sectoral targets with the list of priority PAPs for inclusion in the Agency PIP, resulting from the meetings. Afterwards, concerned RDCs shall be given the opportunity to appeal for reconsideration of the regional PAPs which were not included in the Agency PIP.

During the discussions, the ACOs and RDCs will endeavor to reach a definitive agreement on the regional PAPs to be included in the agency PIP. Discussions on specific projects may continue beyond the Dialogue for future consideration.

- ii. **Dialogue culmination** – At the end of the Dialogue, the RDCs and ACOs shall sign a pledge of commitment containing the following:

1. The list of regional priority PAPs to be included in the Agency PIP [hereby called as the **Priority Agency Regional-National Investment Programs and Projects (ARNIPAPs)**]; and
2. The list of regional PAPs for further discussion between the ACO and RDC.

In relation to item VI.b.ii.2, should the ACO favorably consider additional PAPs submitted by the RDC, they shall formally advise the concerned RDC, copy furnished the RNIP Secretariat, **prior to the commencement of the PIP Updating as input to FY 2025 Budget Preparation.**

**VII. PIP 2023-2028 Updating as input to FY 2025 Budget**

- a. **Agency submission in the PIP Online (PIPOL) System.** The ACOs shall include the agreed-upon Priority ARNIPAPs in the PIP.
- b. **NEDA Secretariat validation of PAPs.** The NROs and NEDA PIP Chapter Focals shall validate the inclusion of the Priority ARNIPAPs in the PIPOL System. The NROs and/or NEDA PIP Chapter Focals will

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coordinate with the agencies on the submission of missing ARNIPAPs within a prescribed timeline.

- c. **Planning Committee (PC) confirmation of NEDA-validated PIP Chapters.** The NEDA PIP Chapter Focals will report on the missing ARNIPAPs to the PCs. Agencies failing to include the agreed ARNIPAPs in their PIP submission shall be requested to provide justification to the PC. The PC may instruct the concerned ACO to include missing ARNIPAPs in its PIP submission. The PC Secretariat shall then advise the ACOs and RDCs on the result of the PC decision on the ARNIPAPs.

**A. Proposed priority PAPs for inclusion in the PIP should satisfy ALL of the following criteria:**

1. Responsiveness

- a. Responsive to the Strategy Framework and Chapters of the PDP 2023-2028;
- b. Responsive to the 8-Point Socioeconomic Agenda; and
- c. Included in ANY of the following:
  - i. NEP for FY 2023;
  - ii. GAA for FY 2022;
  - iii. Multi-Year Obligational Authority (MYOA)/ Multi-Year Contracting Authority (MYCA);
  - iv. Existing masterplans, sector studies, or procurement plans;
  - v. List of Regional Development Council (RDC) - endorsed NG PAPs;
  - vi. Signed Agreements/ International Commitments (e.g., Peace Agreements);
  - vii. Existing laws, rules or regulations; or
  - viii. Regular program (e.g., Health Facilities Enhancement Program, *Payapa at Masaganang Pamayanan* Program, etc.).

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<sup>1</sup> Only PAPs as defined below shall be submitted:

- a. **Program** is a group of activities and projects that contribute to a common particular outcome. A program should have the following: (i) unique expected results or outcomes; (ii) a clear target population or client group external to the agency; (iii) a defined method of intervention to achieve the desired result; and (iv) a clear management structure that defines accountabilities.
- b. **Project** is a special undertaking carried out within a definite time frame and intended to result in some pre-determined measure of goods and services.

### 3. Typology

For ICT PAPs, these refer to capital outlay components of the Information Systems Strategic Plan<sup>4</sup> (ISSP) of the agencies.

Consistent with the National Budget Memorandum No. 142 (dated January 12, 2022), infrastructure capital investments shall factor in resiliency to withstand natural calamities.

- b. Technical assistance PAPs such as research and development, institutional development, human resource capacity building, or system/process improvement PAPs;
- c. Relending PAPs to local government units (LGUs) or other target beneficiaries; and
- d. Government facilities which include the construction, rehabilitation, and improvement of government facilities for the performance of the agencies' function or mandate and providing support to the attainment of the goals contained in the PDP 2023-2028.

#### C. **PAPs for exclusion in the PIP**

The PIP excludes the following:

1. Recurrent/non-recurrent spending for general administrative and support to operations of agencies (e.g., standalone lease of office space, acquisition/procurement of supplies, equipment, and materials, personnel services, etc.);
2. Guarantee-related activities to private institutions;

3. PAPs to be financed purely from LGU funds and independent projects of the private sector;
4. Creation/establishment of an office or organizational unit, rightsizing, and other reorganization-related activities;
5. Roadmap, masterplan, and ISSP of implementing agencies, including continuing or operating ICT expenses. However, priority projects mentioned in the roadmap/masterplan, etc., that are responsive to the PDP should be included in the PIP;
6. Stand-alone preparatory activities for infrastructure PAPs such as resettlement action plan, ROWA, pre-F/S, F/S, and detailed engineering design, among others;
7. Funding facilities managed by implementing agencies as part of their regular program/mandate, which provide financing for project pre-investment activities (e.g., F/S Fund);
8. Acquisition of lots;
9. Construction, improvement, rehabilitation, restoration or maintenance of a single unit of a building/ structure (e.g., office, room), unless it shall be done for the protection and preservation of cultural properties as defined by R.A. No. 10066 or the National Cultural Heritage Act of 2009; and
10. Landscaping, site development, installation of perimeter fence or similar non-infrastructure items which may not contribute specifically to the country's productive capacity, unless it shall be done for the protection and preservation of cultural properties as defined by the National Cultural Heritage Act of 2009.

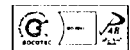
