

REQUEST FOR COORDINATION MEETING ON NGCP'S LAND TENURE COMPLIANCE

AFFECTING ITS EXISTING TRANSMISSION FACILITIES

Dear USEC CUNA:

In line with the on-going program of the National Grid Corporation of the Philippines (NGCP) to secure land tenure from government regulators for its existing transmission facilities occupying public lands, we would like to request a face-to-face coordination meeting with the concerned officials of DENR preferably on July 26 and 27, 2023, with the venue to be confirmed by the parties.

The meeting intends to seek clarifications on relevant policy/regulation in order for NGCP to align its approach to regulatory compliance. We believe that the DENR Central Office officials specifically from BMB, FMB, EMB and MGB can provide valuable insights and expert guidance on the matter. Initially, all issues were collectively gathered from NGCP's representations with your regional offices, EMB, MGB, PENRO, and CENRO during our tenure-compliance coordination meetings with them.

Below is the proposed meeting agenda:

- 1. NGCP's Tenurial Instrument Management Program (TIMP) covering existing transmission lines, substations, repeater stations, and related facilities in all Region's protected areas and forestland;
- 2. Documentary and process flow for SAPA, FLAq, FLA and MLA requirements;
- 3. User's Fee / Rental fees:
- 4. Inputs for NGCP's in-house development of the framework/activity details for CDMP, Rehabilitation Plan, and ECC/EIS including exemption for existing power transmission facilities installed, commissioned and operated before 1982;
- 5. Peculiarities (past and present) of the transmission facilities, operation and maintenance, its magnitude, and tenure-compliance challenges; and
- 6. Other comments, suggestions, agreements, and forward actions.

Given the crucial role of NGCP's transmission system in the power industry, we hope to clarify all issues associated with the above-stated agenda to expedite our compliance with DENR's relevant policies and regulations.
