Legislation, on the Ongoing and Proposed Reclamation Projects in Manila Bay and their Latent Effects in the Environment, and on the Evaluation Process Conducted by the Philippine Reclamation Authority in the Approval of the Reclamation Projects (Introduced by Senator Aquilino "Koko" Pimentel III).
