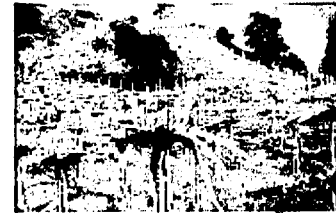

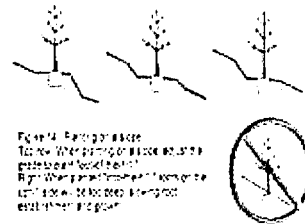
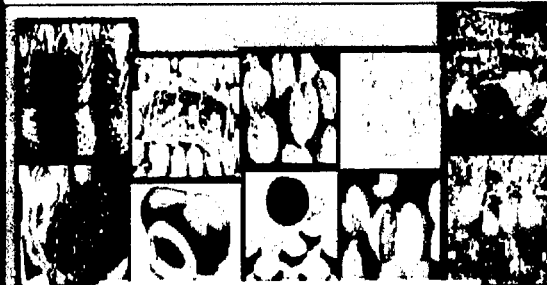


Figure 14. Planting on slope. To see other planting methods on a slope, see the "Soil" section. Right: When planting on a slope, the soil should be loosened and planted in a row.

PROSPECTS:

- Use available lands in highland that accounts to about 7M hectares; 50 % is barren or unutilized for agriculture and forestry business development.

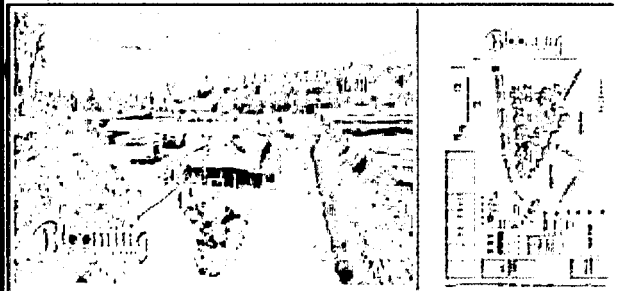

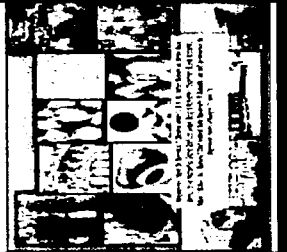

FRUIT AND VEGETABLE COOPERATIVE IN REGION 11 1997/98



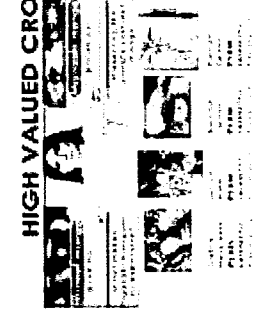
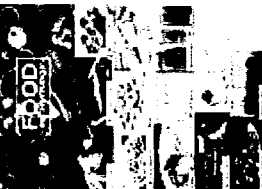
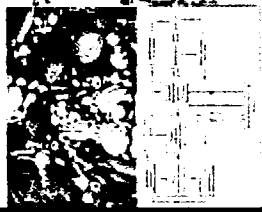
