<b>Bulk Water Supply Project</b>	
Implementing Agency	LWUA
Agencies involved in the implementation	LWUA, DND, AFP, Marawi City Water District (MCWD) and OSG
Issues and concerns	Need to resolve issue on the site of water reservoir and treatment facility located inside Kapantaran Camp, Marawi City. MCWD wants to remove the 25 years provision in the Tripartite MOA.

<b>Sewerage Treatment Plant</b>	
Implementing Agency	LWUA
Agencies involved	LWUA, LGU Marawi City and NHA to make the sewerage system inside MAA fit to the design and plan of the project
Issues and concerns	Series of delays in the procurement process conducted by LWUA. The Marawi City LGU requested the LWUA to stop the procurement process.

<b>Permanent Shelter Project (Brgy. Gadongan-Kilala)</b>	
Implementing Agency	NHA
Agencies involved	NHA, Marawi City LGU and PLGU
Issues and concerns	Illegal entry of IDPs from the temporary shelter in Brgy. Rorogagus to the permanent shelter located in Brgy. Gadongan-Kilala, Marawi City.

<b>Permanent Shelter Project (Brgy. Patani)</b>	
Implementing Agency	SHFC
Agencies involved	SHFC and DBM
Issues and concerns	DBM needs to approve the utilization of fund with SHFC in order to pay the landowner of the project site. The SHFC should fast-track the completion of land development to avoid possible danger to the lives of the residents in the area.

<b>Temporary Shelter in Boganga, Sagonsongan and Rorogagus</b>	
Implementing Agency	NHA
Agencies involved	NHA, Marawi City LGU and PLGU
Issues and concerns	Expiration of the use of land

<b>Electrification of the Most Affected Area of Marawi City</b>	
Implementing Agency	LASURECO
Agencies involved	LASURECO, NGCP, PSALM and NEA
Issues and concerns	To settle the outstanding balance of LASURECO to NGCP and PSALM

<b>PCNA Updating</b>	
Implementing Agency	OCD
Agencies involved	OCD, DHSUD, NHA, DENR, DepEd, DTI, DOH, NEDA, DBM, DOF, MILG, BARMM-READI and MCB
Issues and concerns	To identify the budget needed for the compensation and possible new allocation of fund for the complete recovery and rehabilitation of Marawi City.

<b>Donation of Six Units of Firetrucks</b>	
Implementing Agency	BFP
Agencies involved	BFP, DILG and DFA
Issues and concerns	Delay in the turn-over of fire-trucks to the Marawi City LGU.

<b>Coast Guard Station Building</b>	
Implementing Agency	PCG
Agencies involved	PCG and Marawi City LGU
Issues and concerns	Identification of land to be used for this project.

<b>Multi-Modal Transport Hub and Multi-Modal Car Park</b>	
Implementing Agency	DOTr
Agencies involved	DOTr and Marawi City LGU
Issues and concerns	Delay in the implementation of projects. There is a MOA between DOTr and Marawi City LGU for the implementation of the project. However, up to this date no accomplishment has been submitted. The fund should be obligated before 31 December 2023.

Note: It is also suggested that the Commission on Audit (COA) of the OCD should be present for the concerns on the liquidation of funding from the Marawi Recovery, Rehabilitation and Reconstruction (MRRRP) provided to the member agencies of the TFBM.
