WITH ASOEN WORKING GROUPS AND ASEAN FOCALS

HELD ON 12 NOVEMBER 2024

7 9 NOV 2024

This refers to the meeting with ASOEN working groups and ASEAN focals held on 12 November 2024. Relative thereto, the following were the major ways forward agreed upon by the meeting:

- 1. Include FASPS in every ASOEN coordination meeting for the effective monitoring of international projects. In the same regard, we recommend that the Policy and Planning Service (PPS) conduct a meeting with FASPS to align and harmonize the monitoring processes for ASEAN projects and activities.
- 2. The Biodiversity Management Bureau (BMB) should coordinate with the Department of Finance (DOF) regarding the securing of Special Presidential Authority (SPA) for relevant projects such as the Effectively Managing Networks of Marine Protected Areas in Large Marine Ecosystems in the ASEAN Region (ASEAN ENMAPS).
- 3. On Upcoming Events and Meetings of the Working Group The

Environmental Management Bureau (EMB) shall prepare a workplan for the 17th ASEAN Working Group on Environmental Education (AWGEE) for subsequent submission to PPS.

4. The ASEAN Working Group on Chemicals and Waste (AWGCW) will take the lead in coordinating activities related to the Action Plans for

the ASEAN Declaration on Plastics Circularity.

- 5. EMB is tasked with coordinating with the ASEAN Secretariat to finalize the list of attendees for the Transboundary Haze and Plastic Pollution Workshop, as well as the nomination for the Committee under the Conference of the Parties AATHP/Conference of the Parties (COM/COP).
- 6. On the Proposed Activities and Priorities of the Philippines for ASEAN Chairship in 2026 - The Mines and Geosciences Bureau (MGB) is requested to submit a list of proposed Philippine priorities at the regional level in anticipation of the Secretary's upcoming request.
- 7. On the Confirmation of ASOEN Working Group National Focal Points and draft Special Order for ASOEN - Concerned offices are requested to allocate funding for the participation of national representatives in ASEAN-related activities.
- 8. On the Indicative Calendar, focals should update the indicative calendar of events of upcoming activities, meetings, and conferences

BACKGROUND

This meeting marks the beginning of the regular updates and preparations for the 2026 ASEAN Summit, with a particular focus on the environment and climate change sector. As the Philippines holds the Chairmanship from 2023 to 2025, it is crucial to align the priorities for the environment and climate sector with the broader objectives of the summit. The discussions during this session will serve as a foundation for identifying and shaping the key environmental and climate issues that need to be raised at the upcoming ASEAN Summit. This is similar to the preparatory meeting held for ASOEN earlier this year, ensuring continuity and coherence in addressing the region's environmental challenges and advancing collective efforts on climate action. The inputs gathered here will play a pivotal role in framing the strategic priorities for ASEAN's environment and climate change agenda for the 2026 Summit.

HIGHLIGHTS OF DISCUSSIONS

- Key agreements and updates of the 35th Meeting of the ASEAN Senior Officials on the Environment (% Ms. Anna Michelle Lim)
 - ASEAN Declaration on Plastics Circularity
 - This document has been adopted.
 - ASOEN National focal points will consolidate the comments of relevant Working Groups and submit them to Lao PDR.
 - Some Philippine positions, including chemicals of concern and plastic waste trade, were not included in the document endorsed by ASOEN and AMME on October 5, 2024, because Malaysia and Indonesia had a redline, but this will not affect the position of the Philippines to the INC.
 - The ASEAN Joint Statement on Biodiversity for CBD COP 16 and the Joint Statement on Climate Change for UNFCCC COP 29 were adopted at the

44th and 45th ASEAN Summits in Vientiane, Lao PDR.

- Establishment Agreement on the ASEAN Centre for Climate Change
 - The Philippines has already submitted the Instrument of Full Powers (IFP) to the ASEAN Secretariat and has signed the Agreement
 - It was noted that the Climate Change Center is hosted in Brunei
- Establishment Agreement on the ASEAN Coordinating Centre for Transboundary Haze Pollution Control
 - Instrument of Full Powers (IFP) has been signed by the ENR Secretary
 - The ACC THPC will be hosted in Indonesia
- The End-Term Review of the ASEAN Socio-Cultural Community (ASCC) Blueprint 2025 will be finalized in 2025. The implementing partner may request interviews or focus group discussions with sectoral bodies and working groups.
- Key agreements and updates from ASOEN Working Groups, COM/COP to the ASEAN Agreement on Transboundary Haze Pollution
 - o MGB on AMMin/ASOMM (% Ms. Florian Servidad)
 - It was noted that MGB is part of a different It was noted that MGB belongs to a different sectoral body, but there are connections to ASCC activities. This meeting aims to align ASEANwide activities, not just those of individual sectoral bodies.
 - ASEAN Ministerial Meeting on Minerals (AMMin) aims to present the current implementation and monitoring status of the ASEAN Mineral Cooperation Action Plan Phase III 2021-2025
 - August 13-15 2024, 12th Joint Working Groups Meeting of the ASEAN Minerals Cooperations -Jakarta, Indonesia.

- 24th ASOMM November 18-22, 2024 Bali, Indonesia.
- AMMin is held biennially while ASOMM is held yearly.
- MGB to provide commitments and expected actions for the Philippines in their upcoming meetings
- EMB on Updates on the 16th AWGEE (% Ms. Francisco)
 - The WG is focused on the Implementation of environmental education in ASEAN Countries. Here in the Philippines, they are in search of a sustainable eco-friendly schools.
 - Sustainable Consumption and Production (SCP) is under the purview of AWGEE and various activities and programs under this were presented.
 - They clarified that most of their activities are in support of other activities.
 - They will be pushing more on integrating environmental education into the curriculum.
 - On the Regional level, the EMB pushes for a youth program on Green Education and Envi Icon will be part of the ASEAN Youth Eco-Champions Award (AYECA) that is being funded by Japan.
- o BMB on AWGCME (% Ms. Alita Sangalang)
 - The 25th AWGCME, hosted by Lao PDR with BMB attending online, covered key topics such as coastal and marine area conservation, endangered species protection, tanker desludging and oil spill reduction, pollution mitigation (nutrients, debris, eutrophication), invasive alien species, climate change impacts on coastal areas, and integrated coastal management and marine spatial planning.
 - The Philippines will host the AWGCME Meeting in 2027. There is no hosting for next year, but BMB will be updating PPS if there are any changes.

- o AWGCW Chemicals (% Mr. Philip Aquino)
 - The WG conducted several activities such as capacity building and technical assistance on Minamata Convention and ASEAN Regulatory Cooperation Platform 2023
 - Dir. Leal suggested a possible partnership with US-ABC through AWGCW.
- EMB on COM/COP Transboundary Haze and Plastic Pollution (% Mr. Chadbert Aquino)
 - EMB was recently able to be part of Transboundary Haze and Plastic Pollution. There will be a workshop on December 10-12 2024 that will be hosted by Lao PDR.
 - SWMD and AQMS to participate in the COM/COP in Bangkok, Thailand.
- Ongoing ASEAN projects and participation of DENR
 - BMB on AWGCME (% Ms. Alita Sangalang)
 - Discussed the aim of each project under the WG and highlighted the following activities:
 - 3RProMar conducts regional workshops that are in coordination with EMB. A knowledge-sharing conference in Bacolod City was held to share 3RProMar objectives.
 - Mr. Bravante noted that the Norwegian Project (implemented by PEMSEA) and SEAMAP (implemented by ASEC) are not included in the FASPS portfolio.
 - AWGESC (% Ms. Consolacion Crisostomo)
 - They provided information on the following Foreign assisted project under the AWGESC:
 - Smart Green ASEAN Cities (SGAC) Programme
 - ASEAN SDGs Frontrunner Cities Phase 2
 - Air Quality Improvement Program in ASEAN
 - Clean Air for Sustainable ASEAN

- Advancing ASEAN-Korean cooperation in Integrated Municipal Solid Waste Management (IMSWM) for Environmentally Sustainable Cities
- ASEAN-GIZ Project "Reduce, Reuse, Recycle to Protect the Marine Environment and Coral Reefs (3RproMar)"
- EMB on Updates on the 16th AWGEE (% Ms. Ma. Cristina Francisco)
 - Ms. Francisco mentioned that they have been holding meetings on the Green Transition Initiatives Project with Korea, focusing on Plastics Circularity and programs in collaboration with DENR and MMDA.
- Upcoming Events and Meetings of the Working Group
 - The 17th AWGEE meeting, chaired and hosted by the Philippines, is scheduled for July 2025, with a tentative venue in Metro Manila or Iloilo. EMB will inform PPS of the final schedule, which may coincide with the 36th ASOEN. The total budget is Php 3,000,000.
 - 23rd AWGESC meeting in June 2025 hosted by Vietnam
 - The 2025 ASOMM and AMMin will be held in Lao
 PDR
 - The 2026 ASOMM will be held in Malaysia
- Proposed Activities and Priorities of the Philippines for ASEAN Chairship in 2026 (% Dir. Cheryl Leal)
 - The Philippines will be initiating the drafting of the ASEAN Joint Statement to the UNFCCC and the ASEAN Joint Statement to the CBD as the ASEAN Chair for 2026.
 - Post-2025 ASEAN Strategic Plan on the Environment (ASPEN)
 - ASOEN Strategic Plan will be aligned to the Post-2025 ASCC Plan.

- ASOEN has initiated the crafting and development of the ASPEN.
- Provides an opportunity to streamline the workstreams of seven working groups that may be adapted during the Chairship of the Philippines.
- Project Proposal re: Enhancing the AMS' Capacities for Climate Risk Management and Other Actions to Avert, Minimize and Address Loss and Damage
- ASEAN Declaration on Plastics Circularity
 - An opportunity to spearhead the development of a Regional Action Plan on Plastics, similar to the ASEAN Regional Action Plan for Combating Marine Debris in AMS with adoption aimed for the PH ASEAN Chairship in 2026.
- ASEAN Biodiversity Framework
 - Dir. Leal informed BMB to align their activities with the framework.
- Capacity Building/Forum on Natural Capital Accounting
 - We may utilize this and conduct valuation activities within our ASEAN Heritage Parks.
- Confirmation of ASOEN Working Group National Focal Points and draft Special Order for ASOEN
 - It was reiterated that the Ministerial meeting should be attended by the Secretary, with senior officials represented by the head of the office, both accompanied by a permanent staff for assistance. PSC meetings should be attended by director-level personnel and their alternates to ensure continuity. Capacity-building and think-tank dialogues must include a technical permanent employee. Regional Directors may be nominated, but for PSC/Senior Officials meetings, attendees should come from the Central Office to ensure continuity, unless the RD is a permanent representative of the working group.
- Indicative Calendar of Events for 2025 (% Mr. Lanli Macay)

- Dir. Leal reminded everyone to allocate a fund for international travels and hostings.
- The 10th AWGCW Meeting will be held in May 2025 chaired by Indonesia and hosted by Cambodia
 - INC 5 will be on November 25 to December 1, 2024.
- The 25th AWGWRM will be on May 2025
- The 35th AWGNCB June 2025 to be chaired by the Philippines and hosted by Thailand
- 26th AWGCME meeting June 2025 Malaysia. The Philippines will be hosting 2027
- The ASOEN will be held in July 2025 while the AMME will convene in September 2025. Both meetings are to be hosted by Malaysia.
- The Calendar will be circulated to the attendees for them to update the Calendar and for their reference and preparation.

- -EMB to prepare the workplan for the 17th AWGEE for subsequent submission to PPS
- It was agreed that the AWGCW would take the lead in coordinating the activities related to the Action Plans for the ASEAN Declaration on Plastics Circularity.
- EMB to Coordinate with the ASEAN Secretariat on the attendees for the Transboundary Haze and

Plastic Pollution Workshop and nomination for COM/COP.

- MGB to submit a list of Philippine Priorities that we have in a Regional Level in anticipation of the Secretary's request.
- PPS to craft a reporting template for ASEAN
 Meetings to be included in the Special Order that
 will only include a brief backgrounder and
 highlights.
- PPS to circulate the Draft Special Order re: Designating Officials And Personnel As National Focal Points For DENR ASEAN Working And Expert Groups to concerned offices for inputs/comments/updating.
- PPS to draft a memo on the recommended level of participation for the ASEAN engagement
- Concerned offices to allocate funding for participation in ASEAN activities
- PPS to circulate the Indicative calendar of events to concerned offices for updating
- PPS to conduct a meeting with concerned offices regarding the process for international travels not funded by the organizer.
