SUBJECT : **ADDITIONAL DATA ON COMMUNITY-BASED PROGRAM
IN PROTECTED AREAS (PACBRMAs) AND SPECIAL
USES AGREEMENTS IN PROTECTED AREAS (SAPA)**

This is in line with the directives of the Secretary on the assessment and evaluation of Protected Area Community-based Resource Management Agreements (PACBRMAs).

Based on your submissions, the following information were generated:

- Status and general information of PACBRMA;
- Status of Community-based Resource Management Plan (CBRMP);
- Monitoring and Evaluation activities based on the CBRMP.

To come-up with a comprehensive analysis and recommendations, the datasets earlier requested should be completed, and additional information and data on area location (shapefiles) of Community-based Program, copy of the PACBRMA and CBRMP are needed. Further, may we also request area location of issued Special Use Agreements in Protected Areas (SAPA) in shapefile.

In addition, may we request names and contact details of focal person/s within the regional office for CBP in PAs, preferably from the LPDD and CDD for easy coordination.

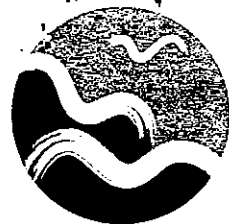

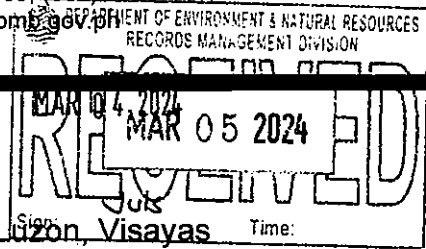

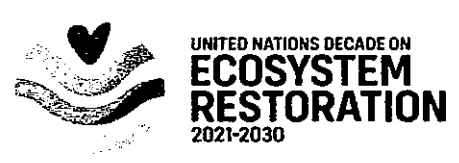
This pertains to the directives of the Secretary in relation to the assessment and evaluation of Protected Area Community-based Resources Management Agreement (PACBRMA).
