

Dear Secretary Yulo-Loyzaga,

Warm greetings from the World Wide Fund for Nature (WWF) Philippines!

Once again, supporters in over 190 countries and territories will create the Biggest Hour for Earth, part of WWF's efforts to turn a single Earth Hour into thousands and millions of hours of action and awareness. In doing so, the world's largest grassroots environmental campaign will shine an unmissable global spotlight on the twin perils of nature loss and climate change. At the same time, Earth Hour will serve as a powerful reminder of the importance of our planet, the need to protect it, and how little time we have to do so – an extremely important reminder as, in recent years, we have seen a rapid and concerning increase in the population not believing in man-made climate change.

The Philippines, one of the most vulnerable to the impacts of climate change, faces an even greater challenge to act urgently and mitigate its effects before it results in dire consequences and catastrophic, irreversible damage. We have already felt some of these impacts affect not only livelihoods but also the lives of Filipinos. Climate change and nature loss are issues that affect us. It is a problem experienced by every Filipino and is relevant to everyone.

Starting as a symbolic lights off movement in Sydney, Australia, in 2007, Earth Hour has always been a beacon of hope and positivity that brings together people from all over the world in solidarity and collective action. First introduced in the Philippines in 2008, we aim to further localize the issue of climate change and nature loss, making Earth Hour not only a symbolic gesture but relevant to the everyday lives of Filipinos and the challenges we face. At present, Earth Hour has already reached over 192 countries, with 97% of the world participating in the movement, sparking meaningful conversations, shaping policy, and influencing leaders worldwide.

In line with our commitment to being part of this global movement, our focus in the Earth Hour celebration in the Philippines is on local challenges we face and how we can come together to address these. With the local theme "Switch off Plastic Pollution, Switch on Nature," we highlight what we can contribute as Filipinos to helping address the immense challenge of nature loss and climate change. We believe that being part of the solution means addressing how we contribute to the problem. This mindset and subsequent actions will be our contribution as Filipinos and as a country.

Happening on 23 March, Saturday, at 8:30 PM, Earth Hour 2024 calls on individuals, communities, and businesses across the world to switch off their lights and Give an hour for Earth, spending 60 minutes doing something - anything - positive for our planet.

- Posting and/or sharing of Earth Hour communication materials (including, but not limited to: event poster, virtual roundtable livestream, virtual marathon publicity materials, press release, etc.) in the agency's external communication assets and using the official hashtag #EarthHour.
- A representative for the media launch on March 5.
- A representative to deliver a message during the Earth Hour Switch off Programme on March 23.



Campaign Objectives

- Leverage local solutions to plastic pollution that are relevant, accessible, and effective in helping address climate change and nature loss. Provide platform for residents of Manila to learn about these solutions and contribute to achieving no plastics in nature.
- Engage Filipino audiences to show solidarity and commitment in taking collective action and showcase this to the rest of the world through contributions in the Hour Bank and local initiatives and participation in the in-person event
- Engage government through National Government Agencies and local governments to strengthen their commitment to take concrete action through policy solutions

Switch Off Plastic Pollution Programme

The program will feature key messages from WWF-Philippines and government officials, talks from our ambassadors, musical performances, a video presentation and a countdown to Earth Hour at 8:30 pm.
