This has reference to the proposed creation of the Luzon PAMB Network which will mirror the Mindanao PAMB Network. The establishment of the Mindanao PAMB Network during the 1st Mindanao PAMB Conference in CY 2015 has significantly enhanced collaboration among protected area managers, fostering knowledge exchange and innovative approaches to conservation. Over the past three years, the Mindanao PAMB network has organized learning events, elevating the skills of stakeholders and contributing to the sustainable development of protected areas.

The proposed Luzon PAMB network is expected to serve as a platform for learning and exchange of experiences, lessons learned, innovations, success stories and partnerships among PAMB practitioners in Luzon.

The creation of the Luzon PAMB Network is proposed to be one of the highlights of the 3rd PA Conference to be held on June 25-27, 2024. In preparation for the creation of this network, the Director, BMB is directed to convene a virtual consultation meeting (via Zoom) on 23 April 2024 with the Regional Executive Directors in Luzon to discuss the proposed creation of the Network.
