CLARIFICATION ON THE GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION SYSTEM (GIS) MAPPING TARGET FUNDED UNDER CY 2024 APPROVED CBFM-CARP REGIONAL WORK AND FINANCIAL PLAN TO COVER CYS 2009 AND 2010

This refers to the Memorandum dated 28 February 2024 from the Undersecretary for Legal and Administration regarding the approved CY 2024 CBFM-CARP Projects and related activities and approved CBFM-CARP Regional Work and Financial Plan for CY 2024 which include the GIS Mapping of CYs 2009 and 2010 CBFM-CARP completed projects. Please be informed that the GIS mapping is in support to the Secretary's direction/instruction to produce GIS-generated project maps and the output is the CBFMA GIS-generated maps and location of CBFM-CARP projects (hardcopy and shapefiles).

Further, the targets indicated in our CY 2024 approved Regional WFP on the GIS mapping are based on the current CBFM-CARP project database which came from the copy of approved projects. We understand that in the past there were different circumstances that happened such as changes of site/s, projects damaged by typhoons, among others. These circumstances were not currently captured in the CBFM-CARP project database.

Relative thereto, the Regions are allowed to change their target CBFM-PO in the GIS mapping with the following guide:

- 1. If the target project of certain CBFM-PO was destroyed by calamities or in anyway not accomplished the project, the GIS mapping will still be targeted in the same CBFM-PO as the required output is the GIS mapping of the whole CBFM area including other CBFM-CARP projects of said CBFM-PO. Provided that the mapping of the CBFM area of the said CBFM-PO has yet to be accomplished by the Region and no shapefiles are available.
- 2. If the target project and CBFM-PO for CYs 2009 and 2010 have been changed, the GIS mapping shall be done in the CBFM-PO which replaced the target CBFM-PO.
- 3. If the GIS mapping of the target CBFM-PO is not feasible such as already part of a protected area, military reservation, Alienable and Disposable (A and D), among

others, the Region may replace the target CBFM-PO and may be replaced from the CY 2011 CBFM-CARP completed projects.

- 4. If the target CBFM-PO has complete GIS mapping with shapefiles such completed during preparation of Community Resource Management Framework (CRMF) or resurveying, the Region may replace the target CBFM-PO and may be replace from the CY 2011 CBFM-CARP completed projects.
- 5. Any changes in the GIS mapping target shall be reported/discussed in the CBFM-CARP accomplishment report together with the justification.

In addition, the GIS map output for the CBFM-CARP shall follow the processes under FMB Technical Bulletin No. 21-A "Guidelines in the Assessment, Survey/Resurvey, and Mapping of Areas Covered by CBFMA and Other Forest Tenure Agreement" and the output such as shapefiles and attribute table shall be guided based on the FMB Memorandum dated 15 February 2024 "Submission of Digital Copies of Maps, Map Data and Information for All Tenure Applications Within Forestlands". Further, the map data shall be submitted together with the RED-approved final map and shapefiles as part of the CBFM-CARP accomplishment report and be emailed to the FMB's Community Forestry Section at frmd.cfs@fmb.denr.gov.ph and DENR CARP National Coordinating Office at carp@denr.gov.ph following the name format in the aforesaid FMB Memorandum dated 15 February 2024.
