PRESIDENTIAL DIRECTIVE FOR THE DENR TO EDUCATE

LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS (LGU) ON THE ADVANTAGES OF

ONE-STOP SHOPS

In reference to the above-mentioned subject wherein the President recommended reducing red tape by establishing a one-stop shop for every industry and integrating it at the LGU level, please be informed that the DENR was directed to educate LGUs on the benefits of this initiative for their respective areas (e.g., increased economic activity, higher tax collections, and budget increases). Additionally, the DENR is to secure their full support and provide regular updates every thirty (30) days until full compliance is achieved.

To comply with this directive, the Department shall adopt the "DENR Services on Wheels" which was initially implemented by the DENR CARAGA. The said initiative is a mobile one-stop shop that will provide communities with routinary services without the need to go to the designated offices. In line with the presidential directive, all Regional Offices are hereby instructed to promptly coordinate and collaborate with their respective LGUs to discuss the adoption of the "DENR Services on Wheels" and the creation of a harmonized one-stop shop permitting system between the LGU and DENR. After which, a report on the actions taken towards this endeavor by the MGB/EMB Regional Offices must be submitted to their respective central bureau offices for further consolidation. DENR Regional Offices, on the other hand, shall submit their reports to their respective Assistant Secretaries for Field Operations for the same purpose.

Based on the consolidated regional submissions, the Assistant Secretaries for Field Operations, MGB and EMB Central Offices are directed to prepare a Complete Staff Work on the status of One-Stop Shop initiatives and to submit the said report to the undersigned not later than 27 June 2024 @ 12:00nn through the official email addresses: officeofuseccuna@denr.gov.ph and usec.fom@denr.gov.ph.

Updates from the MGB and EMB Regional Offices regarding the subject matter must be **submitted regularly** to their respective bureau central offices for consolidation. These consolidated reports shall then be submitted to the undersigned **every thirty (30)** days, as instructed, until full compliance is achieved.
