- 2. Do not leave a field blank. If the required data is **not available** for a particular year(s), **put a dash (-)** in the cell and **add remarks** in the remarks column. If the DENR is not a stakeholder to a particular indicator, kindly **put N/A** for not applicable. State a brief explanation as to why data is not available or applicable to the agency.
- 3. Sex disaggregation of data (SDD) whenever applicable is required.


