#### WAYS FORWARD

- Continuous issuance of Show Cause Order (SCO) and Cease and Desist Order (CDO) and filling of appropriate cases in court:
   Review Policy for the Issuance of SAPA or Clearance for Eco-tourism Projects with resort or structure;
   Make a clear policy on the validity of those areas covered by PA previously released for settlement or utilization;
   Review boundaries of areas for declaration as PA especially if it will overlap A & D or proclamations with conflicting land

- if possible, special management scheme for areas already disposed but necessary to be included for protection purposes;
   Expropriate the protect properties to be reverted into public tand; and
   Approval of PAMO: staffing pattern by DBM.
